Discussion for possible action to indicate the City Council's support of Clark County in seeking to levy a 9-1-1 surcharge on telephone services to enhance the telephone system for reporting emergencies and to purchase and maintain event recording devices; implement the related five-year Master Plan; and create the governing 9-1-1 Advisory Committee

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Clark County proposes the levy of a surcharge on telecommunications and telephone service for the enhancement of the telephone system used for reporting emergency and for the purchase and maintenance of event recording devices. Clark County commissioned a 5-year Master Plan that provides a framework for the creation of an Advisory Committee that will provide fair and balanced representation for the defined public safety answering points (PSAP's) within Clark County, and the jurisdictions that support and oversee the same. The City, along with all other jurisdictions that have PSAP's, has been requested to have their City Councils publicly indicate support.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council indicate its support of Clark County's proposal to implement the 5-year Master Plan, as well as levy the proposed surcharge and create the governing Advisory Committee.
