CREATIVE ECONOMY FACTS AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

Cultural Tourism

In 2022, tourists to Las Vegas spent an average of \$117 on entertainment - double the amount from 2019. (LVCVA)

The "fun economy" - including sports entertainment - has become 14% of the world's economy and Las Vegas is positioned to be at the center of it all. (Bernhard, UNLV)

For nonprofits, attendees in downtown Las Vegas spent an avg of \$60.74 above the entry fee - the most in the state and way above the national avg of \$38/attendee. (Americans for the Arts)

Creative Industry

Las Vegas nonprofit arts and culture orgs generated \$294 million - providing 4,111 jobs, \$183 million in personal income, and \$27.7 million in tax revenue. (Americans for the Arts)

Creative industries in Southern Nevada saw explosive job growth from 2011-2019 with an avg income of over \$80k (LV Global Economic Alliance)

The creative economy is a major pillar of Nevada's current economic position and is crucial to the expansion of other industries. (NV Gov's Office of Economic Development - Strategic Plan)

Community Impact

89% of Nevada cultural attendees said the venue they visited was a source of neighborhood pride. (Americans for the Arts)

Studies have shown that arts and music education have had a statistically significant impact on chronic absenteeism in schools - particularly elementary and middle schools. (NAMM Foundation)

Place-based arts and culture create social cohesion and community well-being. (WE-Making report - NEA, Kresge Foundation)

The U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis reports that arts and cultural production accounts for \$9.4 BILLION and 4.8% of the Nevada economy, contributing 39,683 jobs. This means Nevada's creative economy has a bigger financial impact than mining!

MYTH	REALITY
ARTS ARE A WASTE OF TAX DOLLARS.	For FY 21-22, Nevada legislators allocated \$1,953,818 to the Nevada Arts Council to match federal grants. That year, arts nonprofits in NV generated \$156,253,527 in total tax revenue. That's a \$80 in return for every \$1 spent! (AEPG)
ARTS AREN'T A SERIOUS BUSINESS.	According to Policy Circle, "economic output in creative economy sectors amounted to \$877 billion, which included a \$28 billion trade surplus for the export of artistic and cultural goods and services including movies and video games."


