

**R-15-2024**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF UP TO ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED  
FOURTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS  
TO FOUNDATION FOR RECOVERY, INC.,  
A NEVADA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, TO RESPOND TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC  
AND/OR ITS NEGATIVE ECONOMIC IMPACTS DUE TO THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH  
EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO**

WHEREAS, FOUNDATION FOR RECOVERY, INC., (“GRANTEE”), is a Nevada non-profit corporation established for charitable purposes, and—without affecting or limiting the foregoing—GRANTEE is to provide workforce training and job placement for adults with mental health and substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the charitable purposes of GRANTEE, the Las Vegas City Council desires to grant to GRANTEE up to ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,145,000.00) (the “Grant Funds”) for use in connection with workforce training and job placement for adults with mental health and substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, NRS 268.028 authorizes the governing body of a city to expend money for any purpose that will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city, including a grant to a non-profit organization created for charitable purposes; and

WHEREAS, NRS 268.028 further provides that such a grant of money must be made by means of a resolution that specifies the purpose of the grant, the maximum amount to be expended from the grant, and any conditions or other limitations on the expenditure of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas City Council desires that the City of Las Vegas (“City”) enters into a Grant Agreement with GRANTEE, at a future date, which will provide the Grant Funds, as described herein, subject to the conditions and other limitations described in this Resolution and as set forth in the Grant Agreement, specifically for the use and benefit of GRANTEE and workforce training and job placement for adults with mental health and substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas City Council finds that GRANTEE’s proposed workforce training and job placement for adults with mental health and substance use disorders in order to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and/or its negative economic impacts due to the COVID-19 public health emergency will

1 provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city of Las Vegas.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAS  
3 VEGAS CITY COUNCIL to grant the total amount of up to ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FORTY-  
4 FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,145,000.00) to Foundation for Recovery, Inc., a Nevada non-profit  
5 corporation for the purpose of providing workforce training and job placement for adults with mental health  
6 and substance use disorders in order to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and/or its negative economic  
7 impacts due to the COVID-19 public health emergency. Eligible uses of the Grant Funds may include, but  
8 are not be limited to, the following:

9 (i) salaries/compensation/employment benefits for administration, support staff and other personnel; and (ii)  
10 program delivery costs.

11 RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Las Vegas City Council authorizes the Mayor of the City of Las  
12 Vegas to execute, at a future date, the Grant Agreement between the City and GRANTEE, which will provide  
13 for the Grant Funds, as described herein, for the use and benefit of GRANTEE, and subject to the conditions  
14 and limitations described herein and in the Grant Agreement, including:

15 1. All eligible use expenses must be incurred during the term of the Grant Agreement. The eligible use  
16 expenses incurred by the GRANTEE before or after the term of the Grant Agreement are not entitled to  
17 payment. The City shall bear no liability to fund or provide payment for the eligible use expenses in the event  
18 that Grant Funds are not allocated or received by the City. Furthermore, the City shall be liable only for  
19 payment proportional to the extent that Grant Funds are received by the City.

20 2. The City shall be authorized to monitor the GRANTEE as necessary to ensure GRANTEE complies  
21 with all of the requirements of the Grant Agreement, including the timeframes and performance goals  
22 associated with the activities. The GRANTEE shall allow duly authorized representatives from the City,  
23 independent auditors contracted by the City, other authorized federal officials, or any combination thereof,  
24 to conduct reviews as the reviewing entity deems appropriate in order to determine the following: (i) Whether  
25 the grant funds are being used in a manner consistent with the Grant Agreement and the City's objectives;  
26 (ii) Whether the City's objectives are being achieved; (iii) Whether the grant funds are being used in an

1 efficient and effective manner; and (iv) Whether the periodic reports to the City contain accurate and reliable  
2 information.

3 3. The GRANTEE shall only use the Grant Funds for the eligible uses described in the Grant  
4 Agreement. No other uses of the Grant Funds are permitted unless agreed to in writing by the City.
