For possible action to approve the Las Vegas PRIDE Parade and Festival to be held on October 11 and 12, 2024, including the closure of 4th Street from Charleston Boulevard to Stewart Avenue in Downtown Las Vegas - Ward 3 (Diaz)

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The Las Vegas PRIDE Parade aims to relocate its festival to the vibrant downtown area, offering an enticing array of attractions, including food vendors, alcohol service, live music, and various temporary structures such as tents, bars, fencing, and portable restrooms. With the addition of a festival, the celebration will span two days, drawing an estimated crowd of 10,000 attendees per day. Notably, the parade has a longstanding history of success in Downtown Las Vegas, free from any major incidents.

To facilitate the festivities, Las Vegas PRIDE is seeking road closures on 4th Street, from Charleston Boulevard to Stewart Avenue, beginning at 3:00 p.m. on October 11, 2024. While the majority of the closed area will reopen by 11:00 p.m., a section of 4th Street, extending from Clark Avenue to Carson Avenue, will remain closed until 11:59 p.m. on October 12, 2024, to accommodate the festival's activities.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of the festival and road closures to take place.
