NEW BILLS:

Bill No. 2024-38 - Creates the New Vegas Immersive Tourism Improvement District in the city of Las Vegas, located within the area as further described as parcels adjacent to and generally bounded by Kings Way and Teddy Drive to the north, Rancho Drive to the east, Wyandotte Street and Rigel Avenue to the west, and Sirius Avenue to the South. PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

NRS Chapter 271A authorizes municipalities to create tourism improvement districts within their respective jurisdictions in order to encourage economic development and development related to tourism. In accordance with State law, this bill will formalize the creation of a tourism improvement district within the area referenced in the summary above.
