

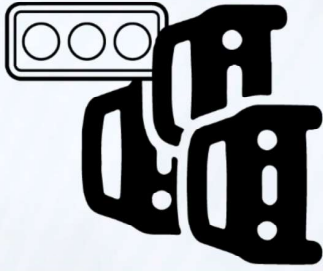

Fuel Revenue Indexing (FRI) overview



- Program that adjusts the fuel tax portion of every gallon of gasoline purchased in Clark County to fund transportation projects
- Enables Southern Nevada agencies to keep pace with rising costs by tying fuel taxes to inflation
 - Continued funding for roadway projects
 - Provides critical match dollars to secure federal transportation grants
- Set to expire 12/31/26
 - Extension is a top priority during 2025 Nevada Legislative Session



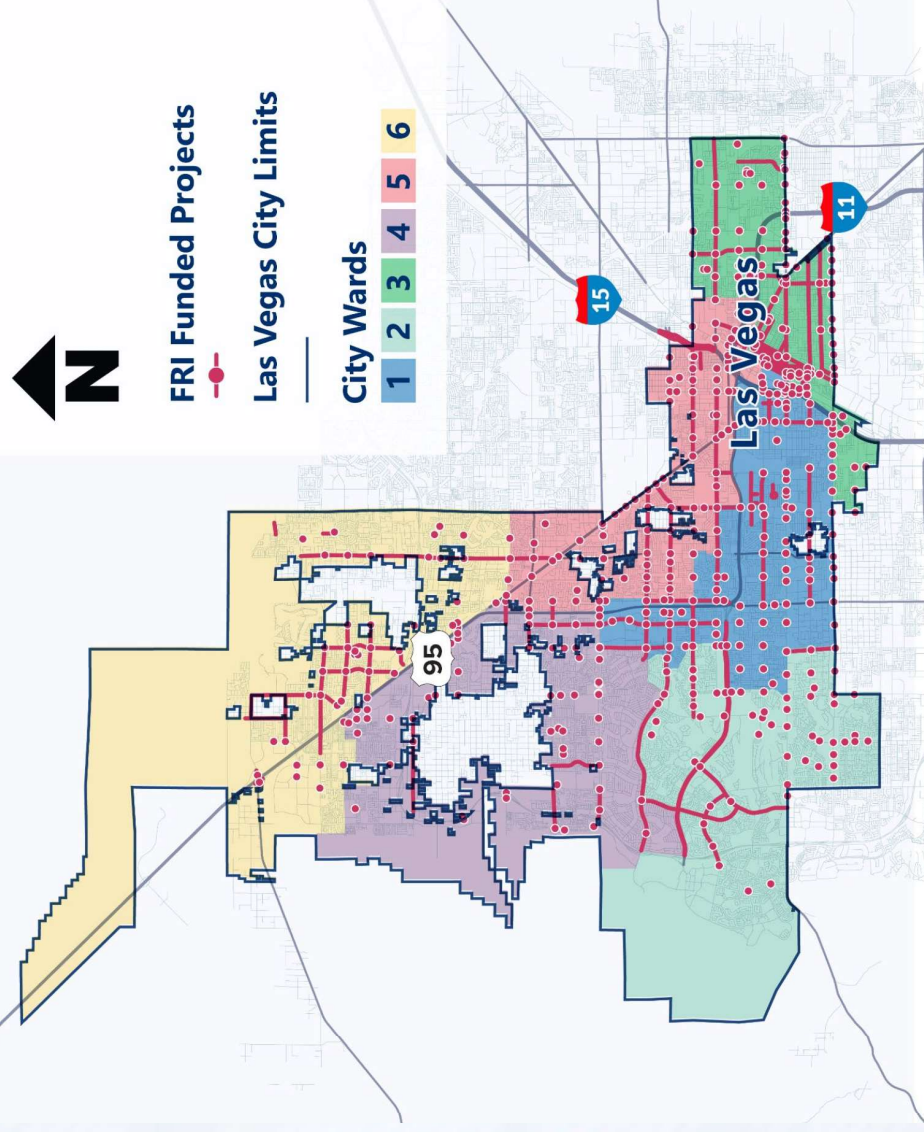
FRI impact to CLV

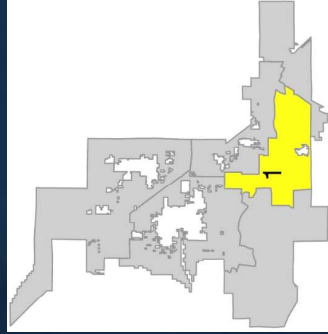


Without FRI, CLV annual transportation funding could be reduced by over \$50M.

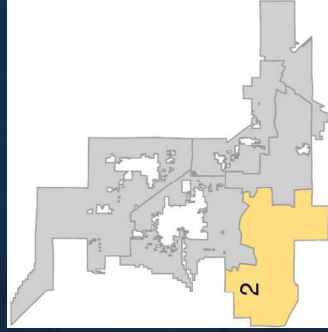


Charleston Blvd Complete

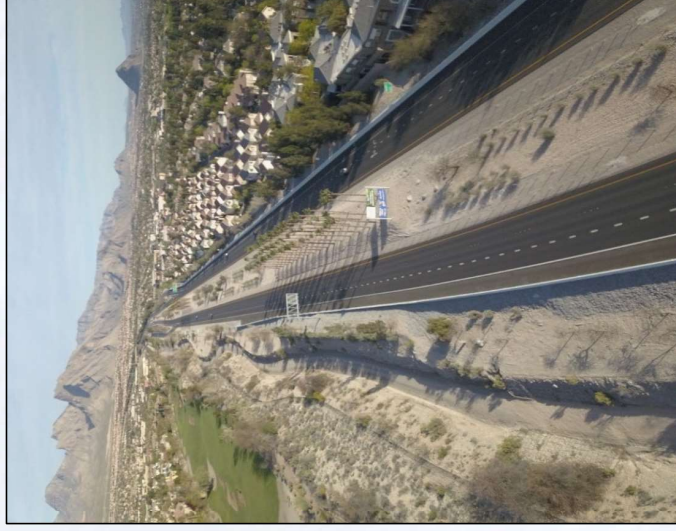


Charleston Blvd/Durango Dr

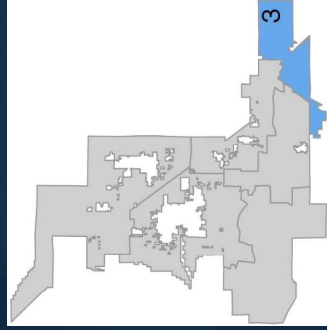

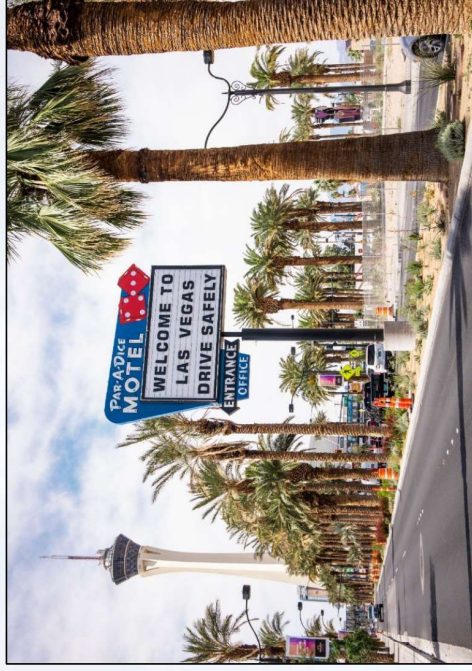

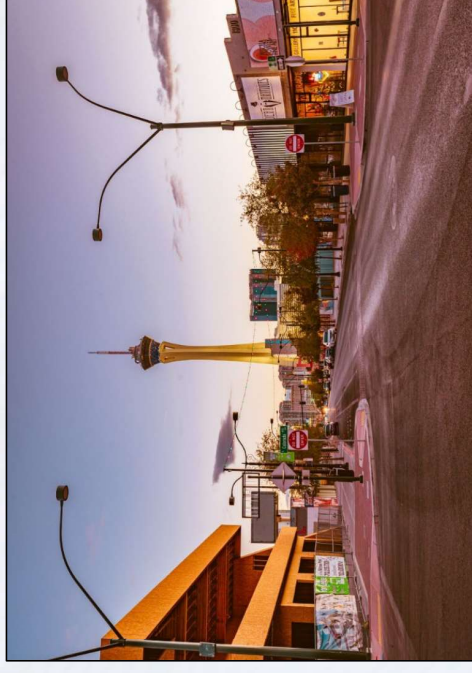

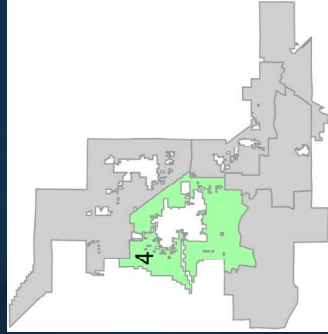


Las Vegas Blvd

Downtown Couplet

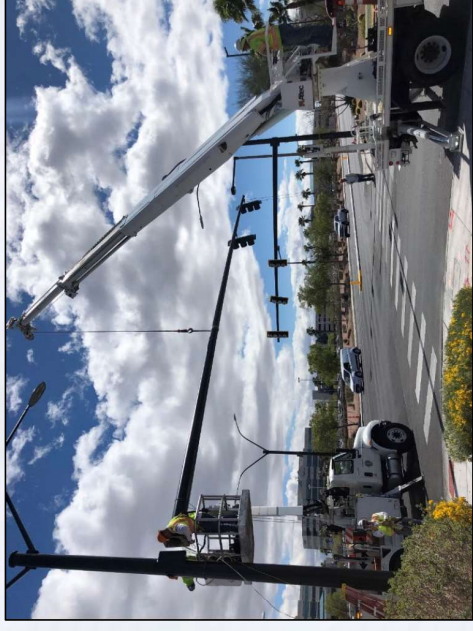

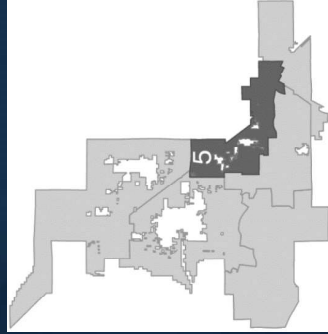


Lone Mountain Rd Overpass

Phase II

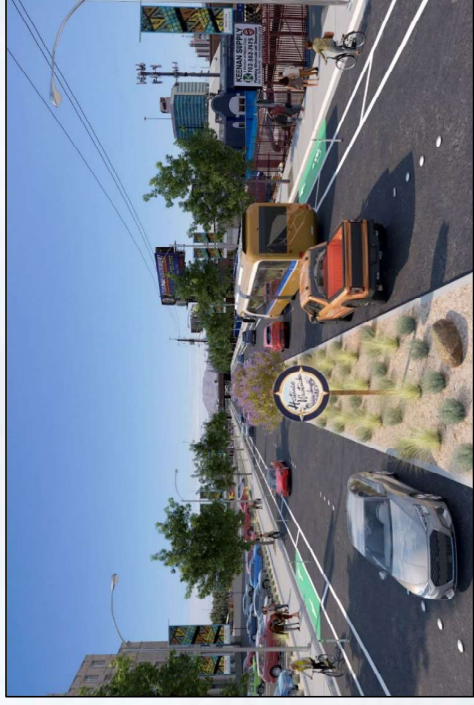

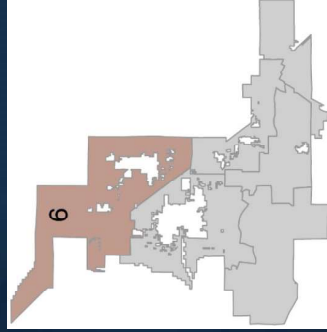


Lake Mead Blvd Complete Streets

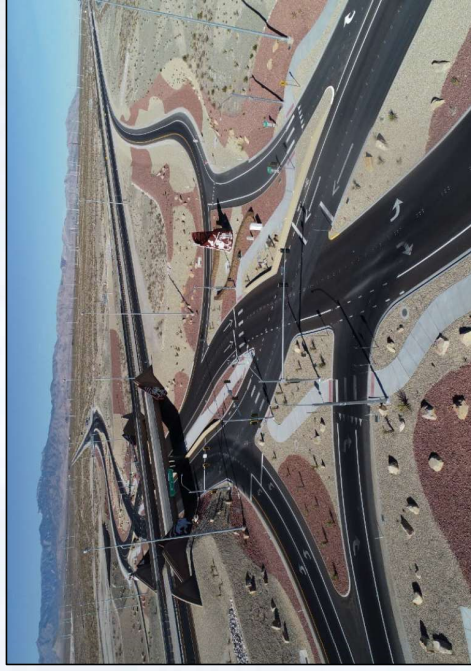


Historic Westside Complete Streets

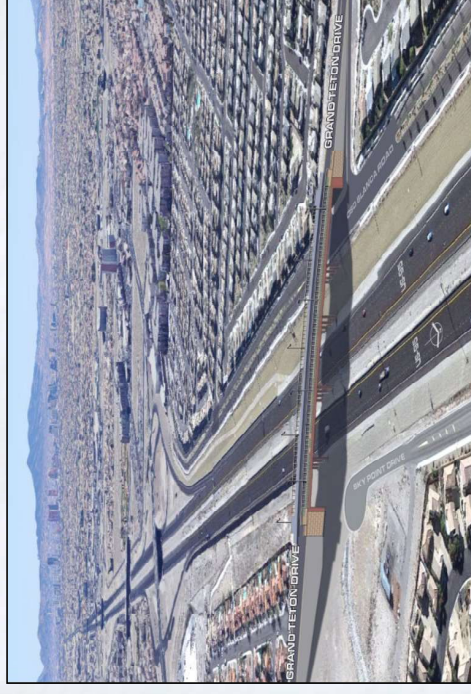

at US-95

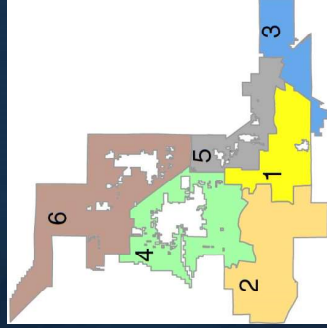


Grand Teton Drive Overpass

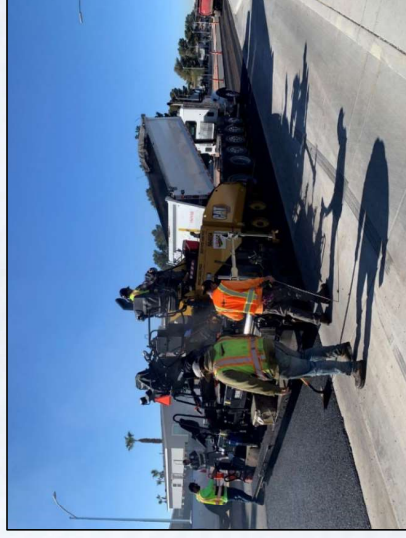
