RECOMMENDING COMMITTEE: BILLS ELIGIBLE FOR ADOPTION AT A LATER MEETING

Bill No. 2023-30 - Amends LVMC Title 14 to adopt a new chapter pertaining to the operation of the municipal cemetery. Proposed by: Mike Janssen, City Manager

FISCAL IMPACT:

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Several years ago the City Council repealed the Code chapter pertaining to municipal cemeteries. The repeal was the result of a determination that the chapter was outdated and had not been used for some time. That determination was based in large part on the fact that the City's cemetery, Woodlawn Cemetery, was essentially governed by an agreement between the City and its cemetery operator. Recently, because of changes to a number of cemetery operations, as well as concerns with activities that have taken place in the cemetery, it has been proposed to adopt a new Code chapter relating to the cemetery. This new chapter generally reflects current operations and practices, but it also contains provisions to allow enforcement regarding issues that may arise.
