

Senior Heart Safety Event



- High blood pressure is the leading cause of heart disease and stroke.
- Nearly 1 in 2 adults have high blood pressure (130/80 mmHg or higher).
- People can improve their blood pressure & cholesterol levels by eating a healthy diet that is low in sodium, being physically active, maintaining a health weight, and taking medicines as recommended.



Workforce Connections - Disconnected Youth Convening



- In Clark County, there are 42,000 youth (ages 16-24), (nearly 1 in 6 youth), considered disconnected - *not in school or not employed*.
- With a disconnected youth rate of 17.2%, Nevada has one of the highest in the nation.
