Discussion for possible action to approve Amendment No. 2 to the Franchise Agreement for Collection, Transportation and Disposal of Solid Waste between the City of Las Vegas ("City") and Republic Silver State Disposal, Inc. and Republic Dumpco, Inc. ("Republic") - All Wards

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**  
On April 5, 2017 the City and Republic entered into a Franchise Agreement for Collection, Transportation and Disposal of Solid Waste ("Franchise Agreement"). On August 21, 2019, the Franchise Agreement was amended to clarify the procedure whereby Republic may request from the City a rate increase for unforeseen economic circumstances ("First Amendment"). This Amendment No. 2 to the Franchise Agreement ("Second Amendment") revises certain provisions of the Franchise Agreement to reflect adoption of a proposed amendment to Chapter 9.08 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code (Bill No. 2023-27) changing the means of determining how rates are adjusted annually, from the CPI-U to the CPI for Water and Sewer and Trash Collection Services. This Second Amendment also updates rates and fees to reflect the amounts as of December 1, 2023.
