Discussion for possible action regarding the Neighborhood Partners Fund (NPF) Board recommendations to allocate \$51,119.93 for 12 neighborhood projects (General Fund) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Neighborhood Partners Fund (NPF) Program was designed to encourage neighborhoods to take an active role in improving the quality of life in City of Las Vegas neighborhoods by enhancing the physical, public safety, cultural, recreational or educational conditions of a neighborhood. The program grants up to \$5,000 to registered neighborhood groups (neighborhood associations and HOA's). This year's NPF project allocation of \$51,119.93 will leverage a community match of \$79,186.60 in volunteer labor, in-kind donations of goods and services and/or financial contributions.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Neighborhood Partners Fund Board recommends that the City Council approve the funding for the 12 neighborhood projects totaling \$51,119.93 and authorizes the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Services to execute the agreements upon approval as to form by the City Attorney. Staff also recommends the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Services to execute documents related to reprogramming in case of unspent and/or recaptured funds.
