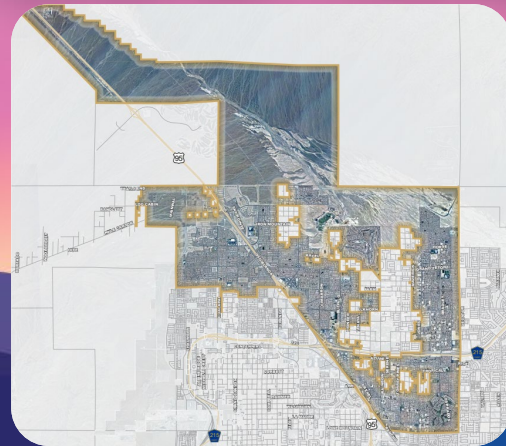

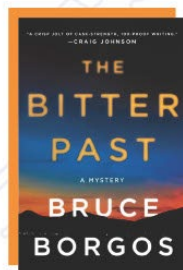
This Quarter's Book: "The Bitter Past" by Bruce Borgos
