For possible action to approve the 2025-2026 Composite Interlocal Agreement related to regional homeless coordination and emergency shelter activities, Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) initiatives, homeless census participation and evaluation efforts (\$256,177.72 - Emergency Solutions Grant [ESG] and Community Development Block Grant [CDBG] Funds) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The 2025-2026 Interlocal Agreement provides a joint regional commitment of \$853,925.75 allocated for federally mandated regional homeless coordination, emergency shelter activities, HMIS initiatives, homeless census participation, and evaluation efforts. The plan includes provisions for sheltering the homeless during inclement weather, as well as for data collection and annual evaluations of the homeless census. All collected information is compiled into a report and submitted to HUD Washington, DC. This report plays a critical role in assessing how competitive Southern Nevada is nationally for federal funding dedicated to homeless programs, services, and housing. All local jurisdictions contribute based on a population-based formula. The City of Las Vegas's contribution to this initiative is \$256,177.72.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Mayor and Council approve the Interlocal Agreement and authorize the Mayor to execute all related documents approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
