**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The Review Committee reviewed and scored applications and recommended these projects for funding. The projects will provide job training, financial assistance, case management, mental health services and life skills training, among other supportive services to homeless and at risk of homeless residents. The City of Las Vegas shall complete all HUD-Required Environmental Reviews (ER). No project may commit and/or expend any funds prior to compliance with 24 CFR Part 58 and final notification.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the Mayor and City Council approve the allocation and authorize the Mayor to sign all related documents following approval as to form by the City Attorney. Staff also recommends the Director of Neighborhood Services be authorized to execute documents related to the award and allocate other funding sources in the event that it is deemed necessary.
