SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve an agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Mountain View Hospital Paramedic Institute for personnel training and paramedic certification, with the terms outlined in the agreement (Not-To-Exceed \$348,500 Annually - Various Funds) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Agreement between Mountain View Hospital Paramedic Institute (MVHPI) and Las Vegas Fire and Rescue (LVFR) for MVHPI to provide the instruction, facility, resources and clinical immersion necessary for certification of candidates provided by LVFR to the level of paramedic. The addition of the MVHPI paramedic program will increase the capacity of LVFR to send LVFR personnel to paramedic school. Cost per student is \$6,970.00. Total number of students sent per year will be dependent on LVFR paramedic staffing needs and allocated funding. Successful completion of the program will culminate with certification as a paramedic, after which candidates will transition to a field internship and final placement into the Firefighter/Paramedic job classification.
