Nov. 9, 2024

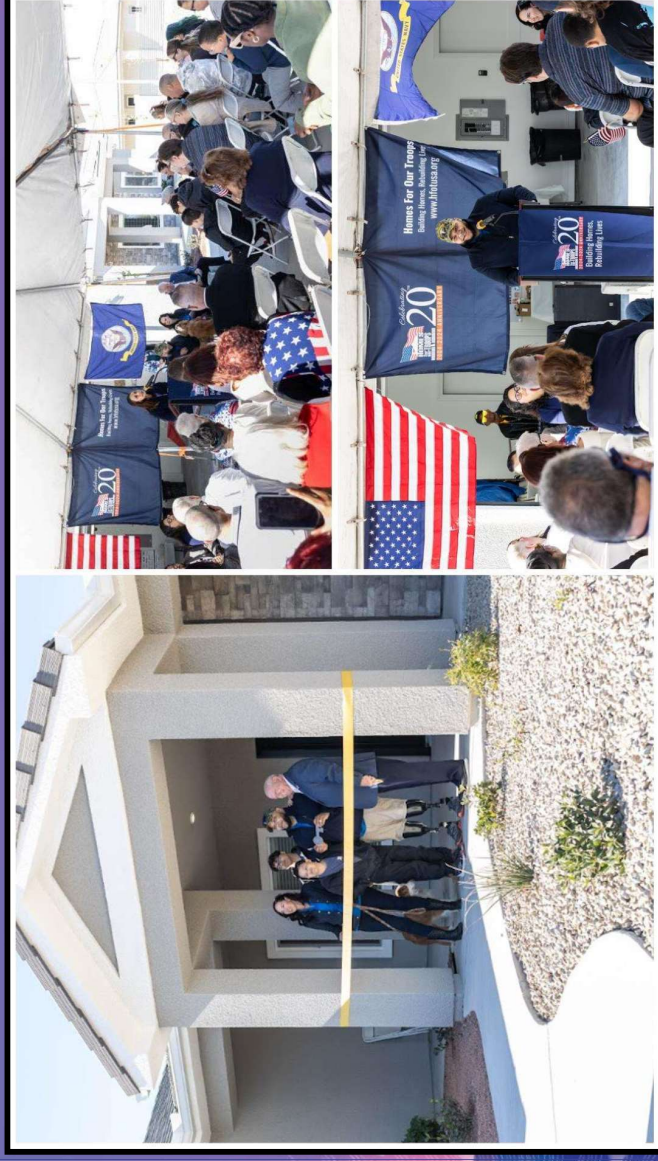
In partnership with Get Outdoors Nevada, Team Brune and 60 volunteers planted 16 trees at Polly Gonzalez Park.

Nov. 16, 2024

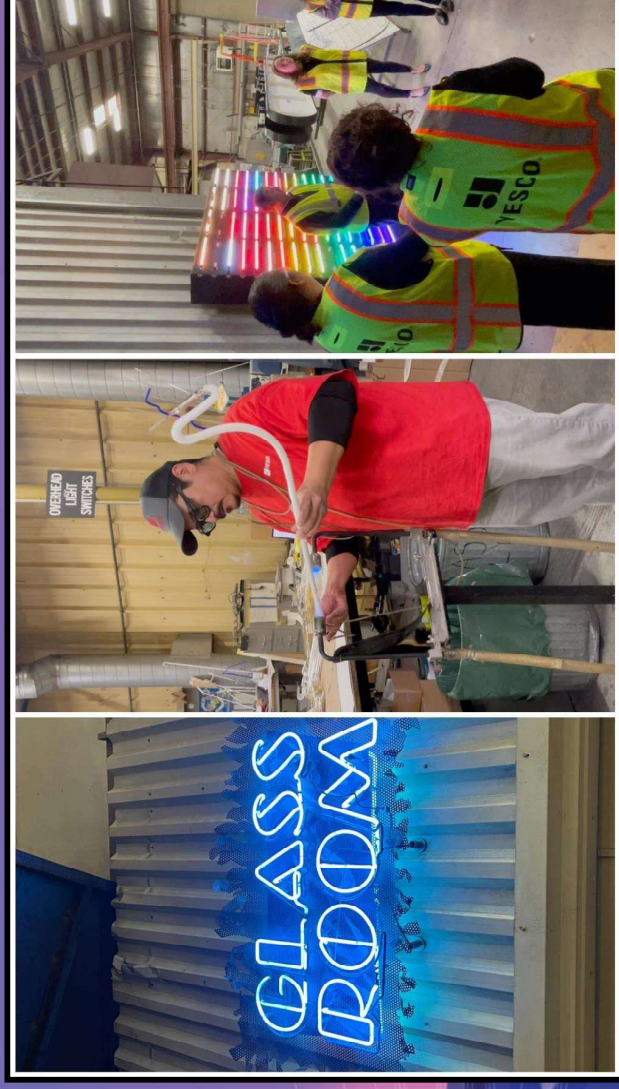

Nov. 20, 2024

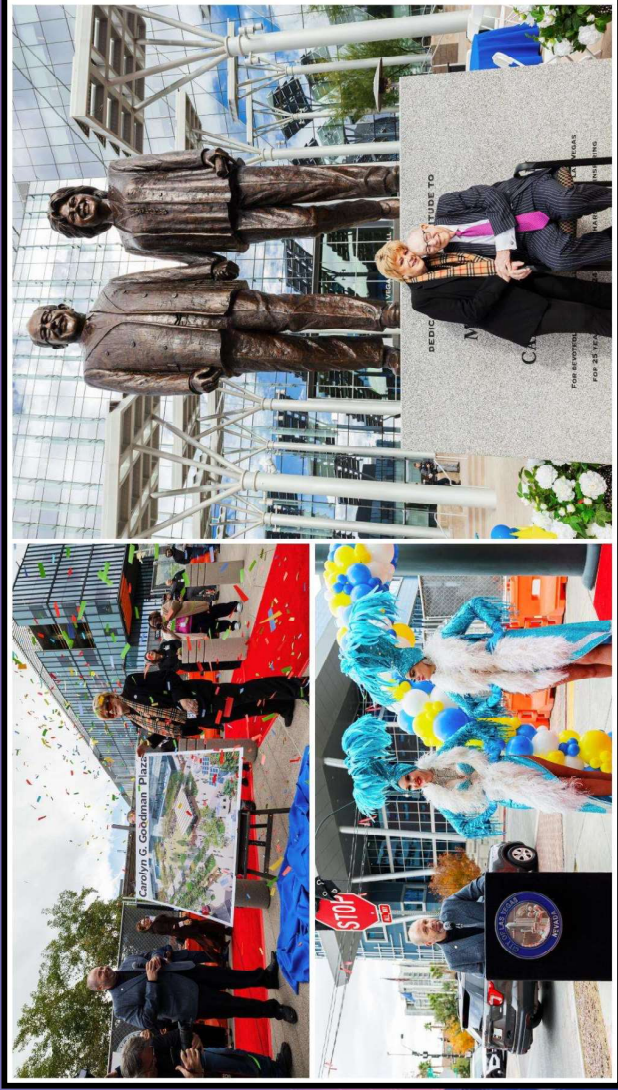

Celebrating Milestones

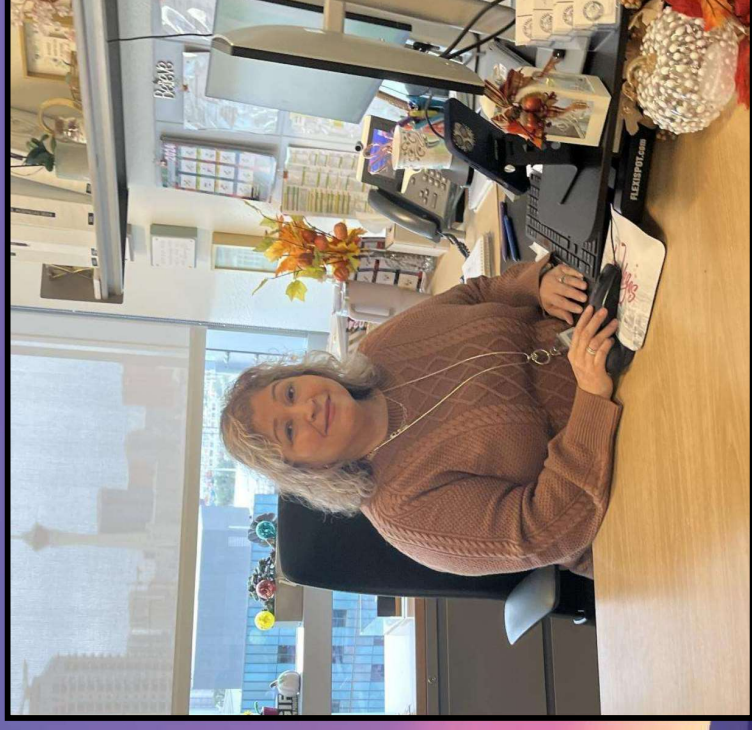
Nov. 26, 2024
