**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**  
The Neighborhood Partners Fund Board was established through Council action in June of 1998 to review Neighborhood Partners Fund applications and make funding recommendations to the City Council. The Neighborhood Partners Fund program is designed to assist the residents of the city of Las Vegas to improve the quality of life in their communities. The bylaws were amended in February of 2000 to increase the number of members from 9 to 13 and again in March 2009 to adjust the commencement date for member terms to April 1. The duration of each term continued to be one year. In 2010, the bylaws were amended as a housekeeping measure to clarify that members need not be City residents. Procedure for this Board is appointment by the Mayor and City Council.
