For possible action to approve award of Contract No. 240148-JL, Lifepak Cardiac Monitors - Defibrillators (including indemnification obligations) - Department of Fire and Rescue - Award recommended to: STRYKER SALES, LLC THROUGH ITS MEDICAL DIVISION (Initial Year \$3,165,000/Annual Support Not-to-Exceed \$127,500 - Fire Services Capital Projects Fund) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This Contract provides for the purchase of 75 Lifepak 15v4 advanced life support 12 lead cardiac monitors with related accessories for Las Vegas Fire and Rescue (LVFR) field use, to replace cardiac monitors at the end of their life cycle. The primary goal of this purchase is to leverage the latest technology and improve patient outcomes and data collection during medical emergencies such as cardiac arrest. LVFR personnel are experienced in operating the Lifepak series of equipment, shortening the learning curve for the new devices. The LVFR EMS Division conducted field tests on other cardiac monitors, and found the Lifepak 15v4 to be the best product to meet the needs of the City and the community. The monitor contains the latest technology and features CPR insight to monitor underlying cardiac rhythm during compressions. This equipment is also compatible with LifeNet Care and is used by local hospitals to receive 12 lead transmissions during patient transport. The Contract includes one year of ProCare support and maintenance services, effective upon expiration of the one year manufacturer warranty. Thereafter, the estimated annual amount for ProCare support will be \$127,500. The Contract requires the City to indemnify the company. This item is exempt from the competitive bidding process pursuant to NRS 332.115.1(d), Equipment which, by reason of the training of the personnel or of an inventory of replacement parts maintained by the local government is compatible with existing equipment. Stryker Sales, LLC, through its Medical division is located in Portage, Michigan.
