- "Mrs. Goulette owned one of the three parcels that comprise the park (APN 162-04-210-103). She owned it from 1959 to 1991 per the county assessor. She was from Phoenix and graduated from Arizona University in 1941, with a dual degree in mathematics and education. She then completed her master's degree in education at the University of Nevada, Reno. In 1955, she became one of the first female elementary school principals in Clark County, at Bonanza Elementary, Vail Pittman Elementary (appointed by the former governor himself to lead his namesake school) and Bertha Ronzone Elementary. - Dr. Robert Clark was a veterinarian that lived in the Scotch 80s. His address was 3 Crescent Drive. While not much can be found online of Dr. Clark, he was involved in the Test Site, studying the effects of radiation on animals. My mother talked to his daughter and she said Dr. Clark lived moved to Las Vegas in 1953, and lived on Crescent Drive from the 1960s until his death in 1997. He was also the captain of the mounted posse, which conducted searches for missing persons in the mountains and Red Rock using their horses. This was a precursor to the search and rescue of today. My mother was at his house on Crescent when a foal was born. He is one of the first veterinarians in the Las Vegas area, and treated all animals. His son Jim was also a veterinarian.
- Wishbone Park: I think it should be called something like "Wishbone Dog Park" or "Wishbone park" because Wishbone is the name of a dog from a beloved '90s children's show called Wishbone.
- Lucky Dog Park (Because any and all dogs will be lucky to visit!)

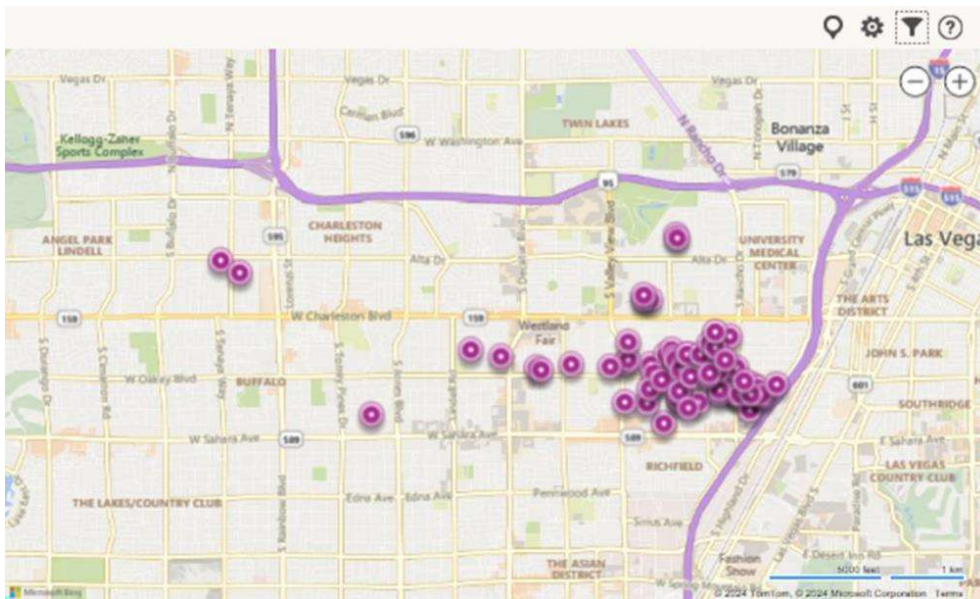

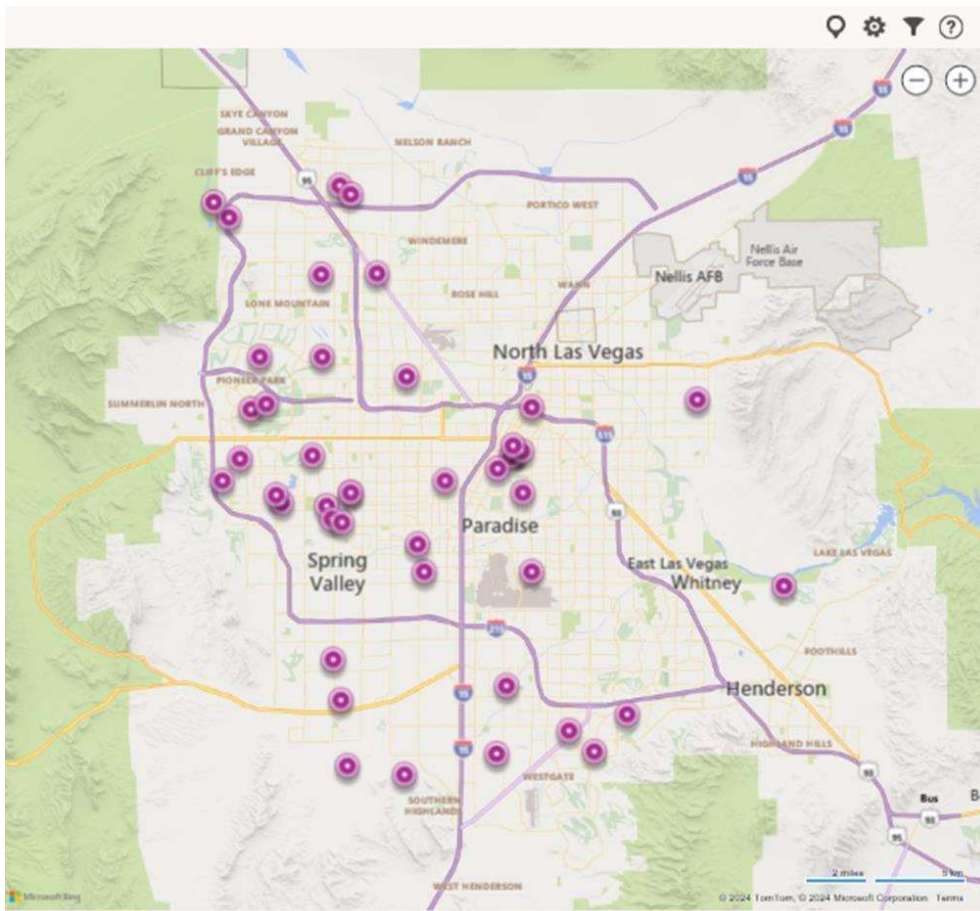
