Drip Repair Program Up to \$7500.00



Drip Repair and Intervention Program

The Las Vegas Water District is collaborating with the city of Las Vegas to operate the Drip Repair and Intervention Program (DRIP). DRIP aims to address and remediate active water leaks in homes causing higher water bills and reduce excess water waste.

ELIGIBILITY: Homeowners can receive up to \$7,500 in assistance. To be eligible, the home must be within the city of Las Vegas jurisdiction and the household's annual income must be less than 80 percent of the area median income. Funding must be used to address any leaks in the home causing excess water usage.

PLEASE NOTE: The home must be the primary residence for the homeowner to be eligible.

When to call 9-1-1







Life and Death Emergency
Call 9-1-1 for emergencies that require immediate police, fire, or medical assistance.




Crimes in Progress
If you witness a crime in progress, immediately call 9-1-1 for officers to respond



Suspected Impaired or Dangerous Drivers
If you suspect a driver is impaired or driving in a way that a crash is imminent




Serious Vehicle Collisions
Crashes involving injuries, immobile vehicles, or blocked travel lanes




When in Doubt
If you're unsure whether a situation is an emergency, call 9-1-1—it's better to be safe.

WHEN TO CALL 3-1-1



Las Vegas Metro Police Non-Emergency: 702-828-3111




Disturbance Calls
Non-urgent issues like loud music, ongoing disputes between neighbors, or other disturbances that do not involve immediate violence.




Suspicious Activity
Report suspicious behavior, such as someone loitering in a restricted area or when there is no immediate threat to life or property.



Past Crimes (No Suspect Present)
Report crimes that have already occurred, such as vandalism, theft, or fraud, when the suspect is no longer on the scene.



Traffic Concerns
Report minor traffic crashes with no injuries





