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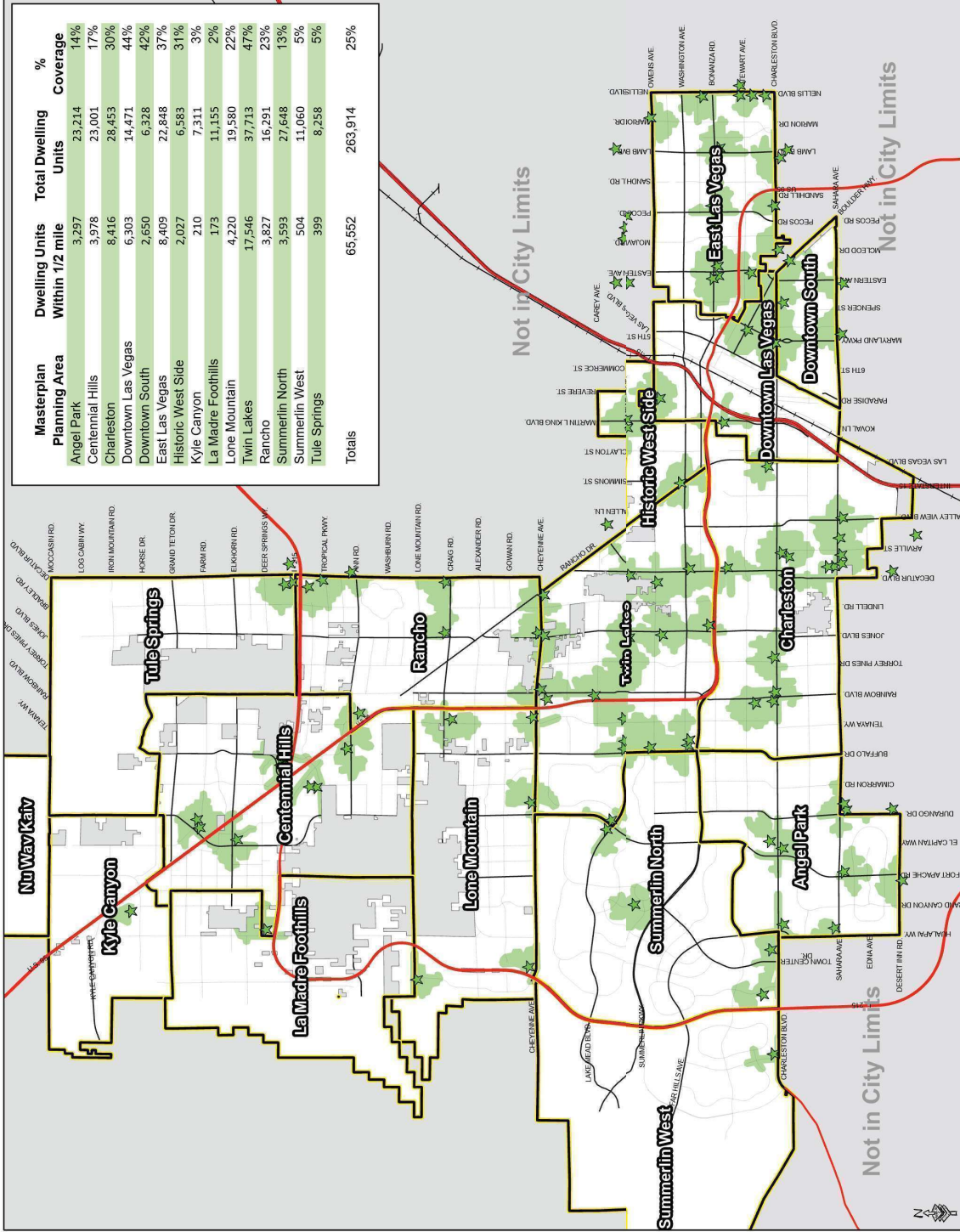

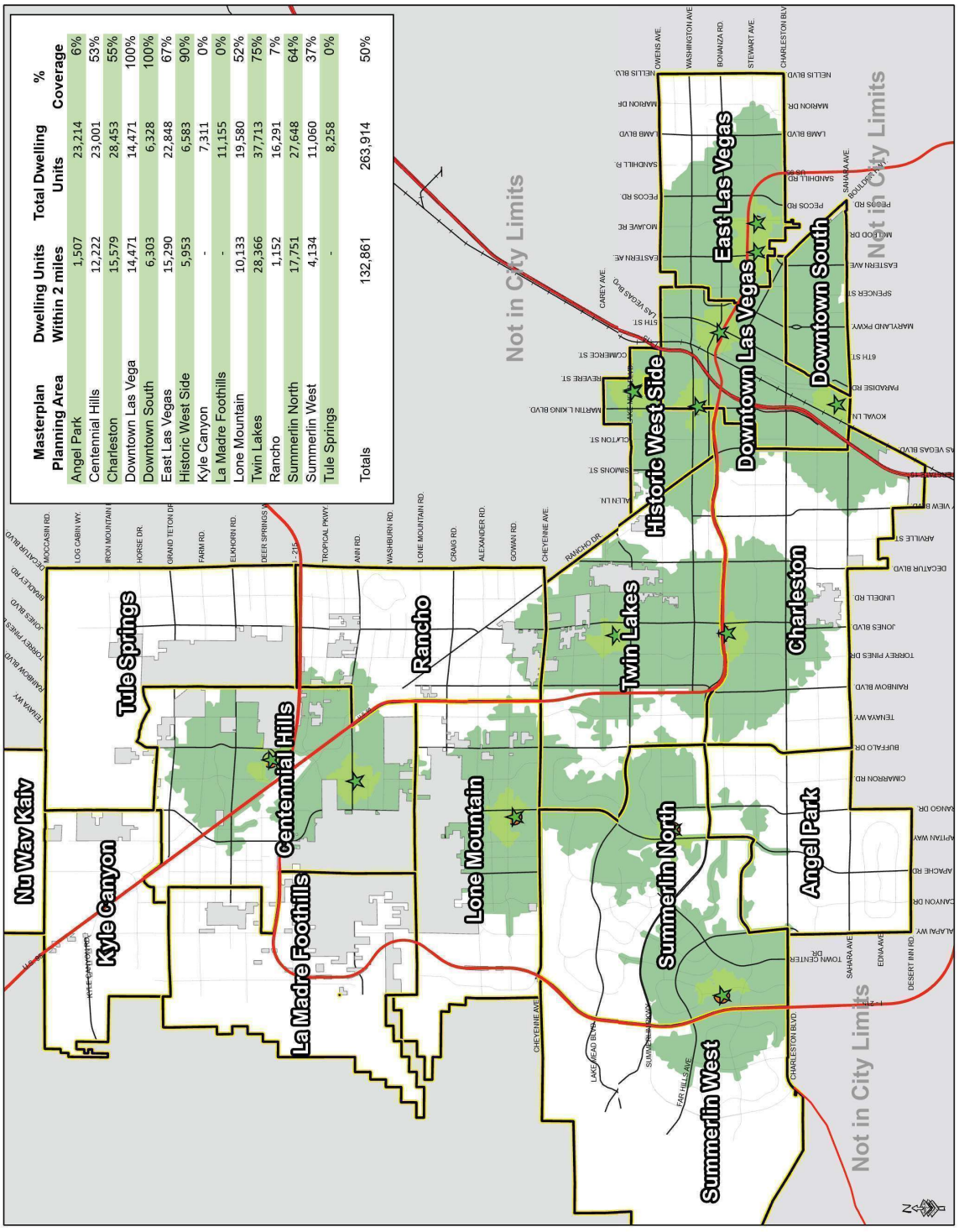

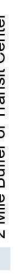
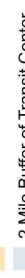
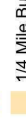
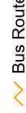
Population Proximity to Transit Corridors (2024 tracking)

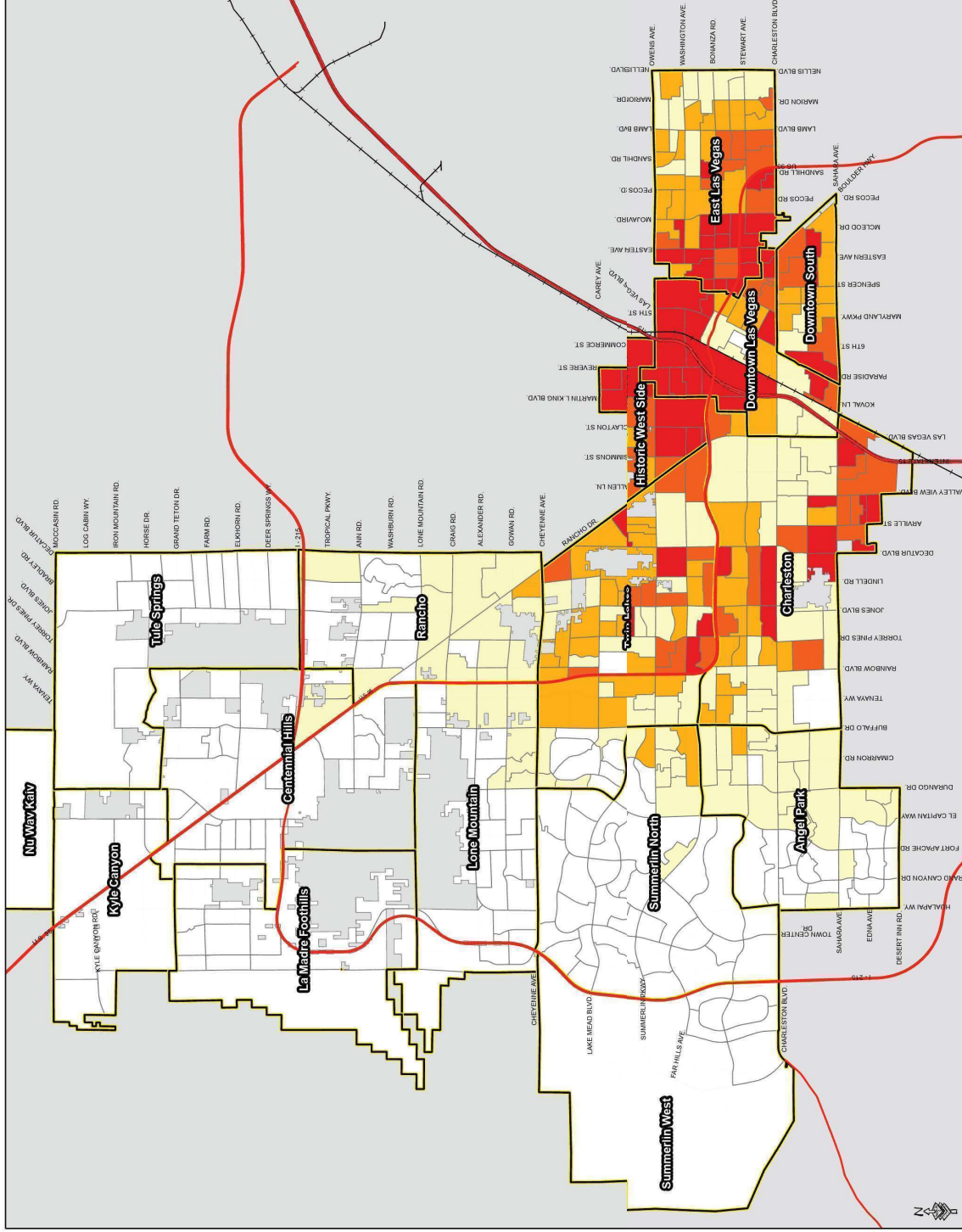

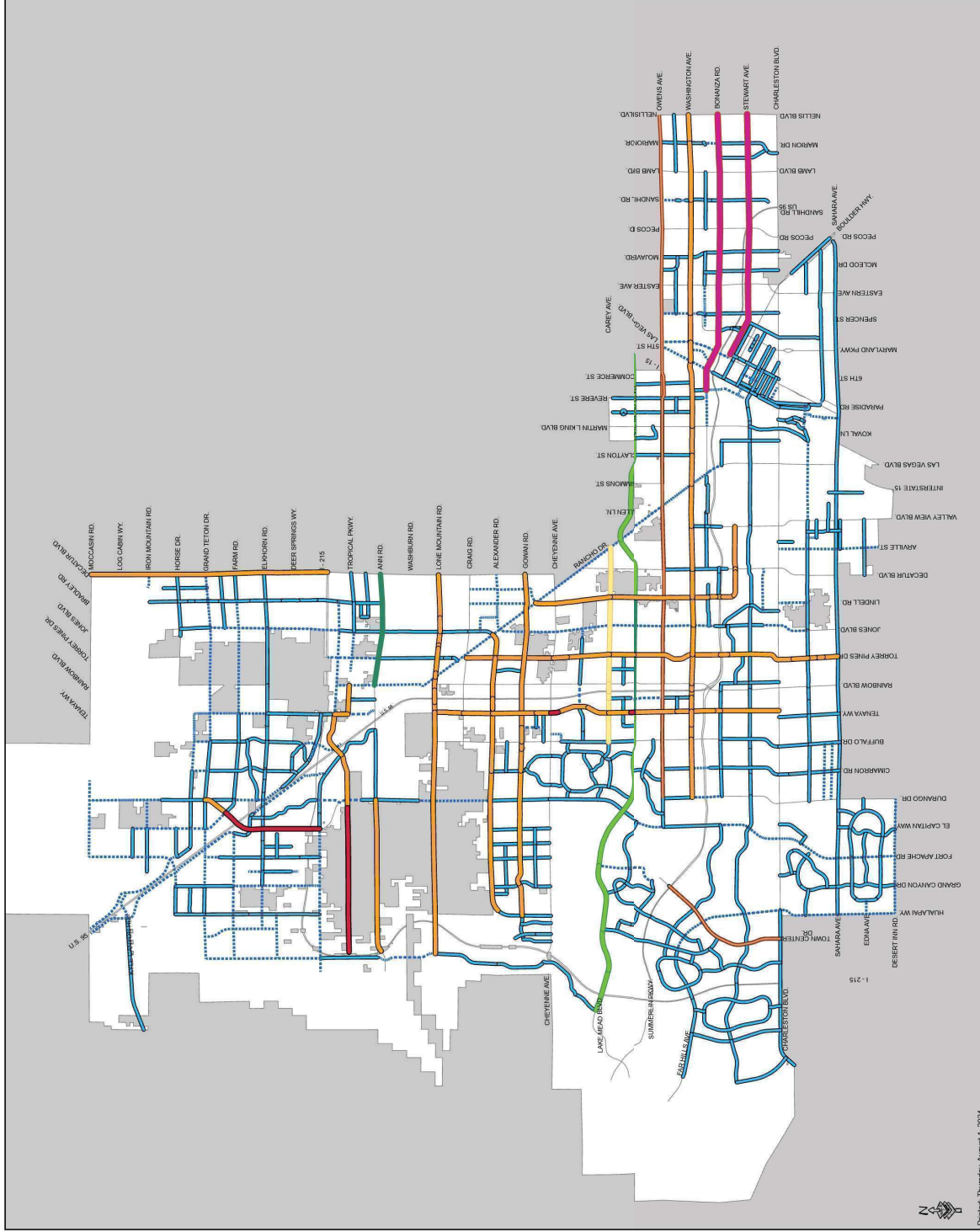
Planned Bike Streets Map
