R-46-2023 - For possible action to approve a Resolution to amend Traffic Schedule 25-I to change the speed limit on Main Street from St. Louis Avenue to Charleston Boulevard from 30 MPH to 25 MPH (\$1,100 - Traffic Improvements Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 3 (Diaz)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:
In support of the City of Las Vegas's (CLV) Vision Zero Action Plan, which is centered on creating safer streets while giving equal importance to all modes of travel, the Transportation Engineering Division conducted a speed study along Main Street between St. Louis Avenue and Charleston Boulevard. This portion of Main Street is identified on the CLV's High Injury Network, indicating it is one roadway with the greatest concentrations of traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries, and speed is identified as a critical factor in the frequency and severity of crashes. Therefore, creating a lower and uniform speed limit along this corridor will promote safe mobility and accessibility. The Traffic and Parking Commission recommended approval of this speed limit decrease from 30 MPH to 25 MPH at their board meeting on May 25, 2023.
