Discussion for possible action to approve and authorize the allocation of funds, totaling up to \$3,040,000, allocated to the City through the One Nevada Agreement on Allocation of Opioid Recoveries, to recommend grantees and programs, and to give the City Manager authorization to negotiate and execute documents related to the award of funds (Community Recovery Special Revenue Fund) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In July 2021, the City Council approved the One Nevada Agreement on Allocation of Opioid Recoveries, which specifies the statewide allocation and authorized uses of any monetary recoveries obtained through negotiated resolutions between the City's outside counsel (Eglet Adams), the State of Nevada, and any opioid-related defendants. The City's allocation is 6.84% of the 38.77% local government allocation after attorney's fees and costs are paid. The City established the Community Recovery Special Revenue Fund to provide \$3.04 million of opioid settlements received through 2023, to community-wide organizations in Las Vegas and internal City Departments to expand on existing opioid-use and opioid-use disorder programs through 2026. The City proposed a funding-use strategy that focused on three of the eligible use categories under NRS 433, which include housing for persons who have or are in recovery from substance use disorders, behavioral health crisis services and programs for persons involved in the criminal justice and juvenile justice systems. Community Recovery Fund awards are contingent upon successful execution of individual contracts. This agenda item seeks approval to authorize and allocate funds to the applicants recommended for award (Exhibit K).

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval for the recommended grantees and to authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute any and all related agreements and documents related to the Community Recovery Funds following approval as to form by the City Attorney, including reprogramming recaptured funds.
