For possible action to approve the Fiscal Year 2022 Reconnecting Communities Pilot Program Grant Award Agreement between the City of Las Vegas (CLV) and the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) to fund planning and design activities along Bonanza Road from Martin L. King Jr. Boulevard to D Street and F Street from Washington Avenue to Owens Avenue, as this project is associated with the Reconnecting the Historic Westside to Opportunities, Bonanza Road and F Street Complete Street Improvement Project (\$2,500,000 - Road and Flood Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 5 (Crear)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The CLV was awarded a USDOT Fiscal Year 2022 Reconnecting Communities Pilot Program grant for activities associated with the Reconnecting the Historic Westside to Opportunities Bonanza Road and F Street Complete Street Improvement Project. The grant was funded under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. This agreement applies to the planning and design of complete streets improvements to enhance pedestrian, bicycle and transit access along Bonanza Road from Martin L. King Jr. Boulevard to D Street and F Street from Washington Avenue to Owens Avenue. Total funding for the project is \$2,500,000 of which \$2,000,000 is from the USDOT Reconnecting Communities Pilot grant and \$500,000 from local matching funds.
