AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC 10.04.010 TO UPDATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE "ORDER OUT CORRIDOR," REGARDING WHICH A COURT MAY IMPOSE AN ORDER TO STAY OUT OF THE CORRIDOR AS A CONDITION OF A SUSPENDED SENTENCE OR DEFERRED ADJUDICATION OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Amends LVMC 10.04.010 to update the boundaries of the "Order Out Corridor," regarding which a court may impose an order to stay out of the corridor as a condition of a suspended sentence or deferred adjudication of a criminal offense.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 10, Chapter 4, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.04.010: For purposes of this Chapter, the "Order Out Corridor" includes:

(A) The area [which is bordered on the west by Main Street from Stewart Avenue to Bridger Avenue; bordered on the south by Bridger Avenue from Main Street to 8th Street; bordered on the east by 8th Street to Stewart Avenue; and bordered on the north by Stewart Avenue from 8th Street to Main Street—all as designated] depicted on the map labeled "Map 1," which is [attached to this Ordinance and shall be] included in the Code at the end of this Section. [This portion of the Order Out Corridor includes the entire width of the roadway and sidewalks of the streets and avenues described above.]

(B) The area depicted on the map labeled "Map 2," which is [attached to this Ordinance and shall be] included in the Code at the end of this Section.

SECTION 2: The Map 1 attached to this Ordinance shall be included in LVMC Chapter 10.04 and shall replace and supersede the map previously designated as Map 1 for inclusion in Chapter 10.04.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by

1 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
2 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
3 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
4 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
5 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

6 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
7 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
8 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
