Bill No. 2024-23 - For possible action - Amends the Lone Mountain Master Development Plan and Design Standards to provide that the use "Animal Hospital, Clinic or Shelter Without Outside Pens" is permitted as a conditional use within the Neighborhood Commercial land use designation. PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will amend the Lone Mountain Master Development Plan and Design Standards to provide that the use "Animal Hospital, Clinic or Shelter Without Outside Pens" is permitted as a conditional use within the Neighborhood Commercial land use designation. Presently, such a use is not permitted within the Lone Mountain Master Development Plan area.
