R-45-2023 - For possible action to approve a Resolution to amend Schedule 25-III to remove the 40 MPH speed limit on Craig Road from Buffalo Drive to Tenaya Way and amend Schedule 25-II to modify the speed limit to 35 MPH on Craig Road from Buffalo Drive to Balsam Street (\$600 - Traffic Improvements Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 4 (Allen-Palenske)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:
In support of the City of Las Vegas's (CLV) Vision Zero Action Plan to improve safety, the Transportation Engineering Division conducted a speed study along Craig Road between Buffalo Drive and Tenaya Way in Ward 4. This portion of Craig Road is identified on the CLV's High Injury Network, indicating it is a roadway with the greatest concentration of traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries, and speed is identified as a critical factor in the frequency and severity of crashes. A future maintenance project will add buffered bike lanes in each direction along Craig Road. Therefore, creating a lower and uniform speed limit along this corridor will promote safe mobility and accessibility for all transportation system users. The Traffic and Parking Commission recommended approval of this speed limit decrease from 40 MPH to 35 MPH at their board meeting on May 25, 2023.
