Authority: NRS 393.092; AB353

Term: 2-Year term begins on January 1 and ends on December 31 of the second year

Appointment: Committee consists of 11 members as follows:

Six members elected representatives of local government determined as follows:

1 member board of county commissioners appointed by a majority vote of the board of county commissioners

1 member of the governing body of each incorporated city in the county, each of whom is appointed by a majority vote of the governing body of which he is a member.

If the county and cities' membership is less than six, one additional member of the board of county commissioners and, if applicable, additional members of the governing bodies of incorporated cities in the county, appointed as above, until six members have been appointed. If this membership would result in an unequal number of representatives among the incorporated cities, the membership of the incorporated cities on the panel must be rotated and the board of county commissioners shall draw lots to determine which city of cities will be first represented, which next, and so on.

Five members board of trustees of the County School District according to specific criteria set forth in Section 6 of AB353.

After the initial terms, the term of each member of this panel is 2 years; members are eligible for reappointment.

Purpose: On or before July 1 of each even-numbered year, the Oversight Panel is mandated to submit to the director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the next regular session of the legislature written recommendations for financing the cost of new construction, design, maintenance and repair of school facilities. In addition, the Oversight Panel shall review and approve or disapprove a request by the Board of Trustees of the School District for the issuance of General Obligation Bonds pursuant to Subsection 4 of NRS 350.020.
