PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The project includes upgrading deficient ADA ramps, installation of pedestrian flashers ("RRFB" rectangular rapid flashing beacons), systems (poles, push buttons, mast arms, flasher assemblies, signs, and solar power), upgrading existing street lighting, construction of median crossing refuge areas, and pavement marking and traffic signing improvements. CG&B Enterprises, Inc. is located in Henderson, Nevada.
