For possible action to approve a Grant Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Vegas PBS, licensed to the Board of School Trustees of the Clark County School District, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, a Nevada non-profit corporation, in an amount not-to-exceed \$481,700 for the purpose of providing workforce education and training, apprenticeships, and career certification due to the impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency (Office of Strategic Services - General Fund) - All Wards [NOTE: This item is related to Council Item 27 (R-16-2024)]

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**  
Middle and high school students, adults who are either underemployed or unemployed, and local businesses who reside/are located in, go to school, work, and/or do business in the City of Las Vegas will use Vegas PBS' Jobtimize Nevada platform. The Jobtimize Nevada platform is used to match the right job with potential employees, and identify related career pathways, apprenticeships, training platforms, credentials for long-term careers. Additionally, Vegas PBS is a partner with the City of Las Vegas' Youth Development and Social Initiatives department, that provides accessible and flexible online/virtual workforce "best job fit" assessments, skill building training and specialized industry-recognized career certification training for underserved young adults participating in the Strong Future Youth Employment Program as part of a larger City of Las Vegas initiative.
