I am writing today on behalf of the Nevada Cannabis Association (NCA) in support of Oasis Cannabis' application for a consumption lounge SUP, set for the Dec. 20 City Council meeting (Serenity Wellness Center LLC Special Use Permit 23-0240-SUP1).

Oasis has a solid reputation in the community as a well-run and compliant cannabis dispensary in the City of Las Vegas, led by an experienced management team. The dispensary has a loyal customer base, largely comprised of locals. In addition, Oasis runs a successful production facility in North Las Vegas. Between the two locations, the company employs more than 90 Nevadans.

While lounges are a new concept, we are confident that experienced operators like Oasis will ensure that they are safe and successful. Additionally, both the City and the Cannabis Compliance Board have developed ordinances and regulations that balance public safety with a satisfying customer experience. Operators will be held to strict standards to ensure safety both inside and outside lounges – including impaired driving mitigation plans, overconsumption training, air quality control, and enhanced security measures.

We appreciate the significant time that the Council and City staff have put into the process of creating ordinances for consumption lounges and in vetting lounge applicants. Thank you for considering these comments in support of Oasis Cannabis' consumption lounge SUP application.
