SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve an Electric Vehicle Charging Station Site Host Agreement between Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy and City of Las Vegas for the construction of electric vehicle charging stations at the Doolittle Community Center located at 1950 North J Street; Mirabelli Community Center located at 6400 West Hargrove Avenue; and a future parking garage at 1405 South Casino Center Boulevard - Wards 1, 3 and 5 (Knudsen, Diaz and Crear)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

As part of the City's 2050 Master Plan, adopted by City Council on July 21, 2021 (Ordinance 6788), the Plan's Energy and Smart Systems goals identify implementation strategies to ensure development of electric vehicle charging station infrastructure. Senate Bill 448 of the 81st (2021) session of the Nevada Legislature and the associated regulation ordered by the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (21-9004) authorized the Economic Recovery Transportation Electrification Program, which allows NV Energy to offer programs for the development of infrastructure for electric vehicle charging. Under the program, the City will host charging sites at Mirabelli and Doolittle Community Centers and at the Arts District Garage. Approval of the host agreement with NV Energy will allow for the construction and completion of the project as approved. Pursuant to NRS 268.061, the agreement is being entered into between the City and Nevada Power Company d/b/a Nevada Energy, as a public utility, for a public purpose.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the Agreement.
