For possible action to approve the acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$260,663.47 from the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program for Federal Fiscal Year 2023 to implement a pre-disaster natural hazard mitigation program (a non-federal contribution of \$86,887.83 required - General Fund) - All Wards

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The Federal Emergency Management Agency - Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Virtual Inspections, Training and Code Adoption grant program will provide \$260,663.47 in Federal Funding to the City of Las Vegas to implement a sustained pre-disaster natural hazard mitigation program to reduce overall risk to the population and structures, while also reducing reliance on funding from actual disaster declarations, through code adoption and training. The City will fund \$86,887.83 towards the program for a total program budget of \$347,551.30.
