

**SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT NO. 4
TRAIL MAINTENANCE VOLUNTEER COORDINATION
FISCAL YEARS 2022 – 2027**

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT NO. 4 is made and entered into this 12TH day of September 2024, by and between Clark County, a political subdivision; the City of Las Vegas, a municipal corporation; the City of North Las Vegas, a municipal corporation; and the City of Henderson, a municipal corporation; hereinafter referred to individually as “ENTITY” or collectively as “ENTITIES,” and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada, hereinafter referred to as “RTC.” The RTC and the ENTITIES are hereinafter referred to individually as “PARTY” or collectively as “PARTIES.”

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the RTC approved Interlocal Contract 1299 dated July 8, 2021, and supplemental interlocal contracts dated August 11, 2022, September 14, 2023, and May 23, 2024, for Trail Maintenance Volunteer Coordination, hereinafter referred to as “PROJECT,” and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 277.180 authorizes any one or more public agencies to contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental services, activity or undertaking which any of the public agencies entering into the agreement is authorized by law to perform and refers to such as an interlocal contract; and

WHEREAS, the RTC agrees to conform to the current RTC Policies and Procedures, as amended and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the RTC will be the lead agency for the PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, the RTC wishes to increase total PROJECT funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and promises of the PARTIES hereto, the PARTIES agree to proceed as follows:

SECTION II: PROJECT COSTS; Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be revised to read as follows:

1. The total cost for this contract shall not exceed \$712,430.00.
2. Authorizations to Proceed (ATP) are granted as follows:
 - a. ENGINEERING not to exceed \$712,430.00
 - b. RIGHT-OF-WAY not to exceed \$0.00
 - c. CONSTRUCTION not to exceed \$0.00

The remainder of Interlocal Contract 1299 dated July 8, 2021, and supplemental interlocal contracts dated August 11, 2022, September 14, 2023, and May 23, 2024, shall remain unchanged.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATION

TRAIL MAINTENANCE VOLUNTEER COORDINATION

In **July 2023**, Outside Las Vegas Foundation, doing business as Get Outdoors Nevada (GON), decided to continue its partnership with the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) to support maintenance and volunteer coordination on urban trails with the objective of administering and implementing a minimum of **5,000 volunteer hours** for the region on a one-year period (approximately **1,250 volunteer hours** generated per jurisdiction on an annual basis).

This program involves residents and visitors in utilizing trails, promoting awareness of the urban trails in Southern Nevada. By offering volunteer opportunities, participants learn about the effort required to uphold a world class trail system, fostering a deeper connection with the trails in their communities.

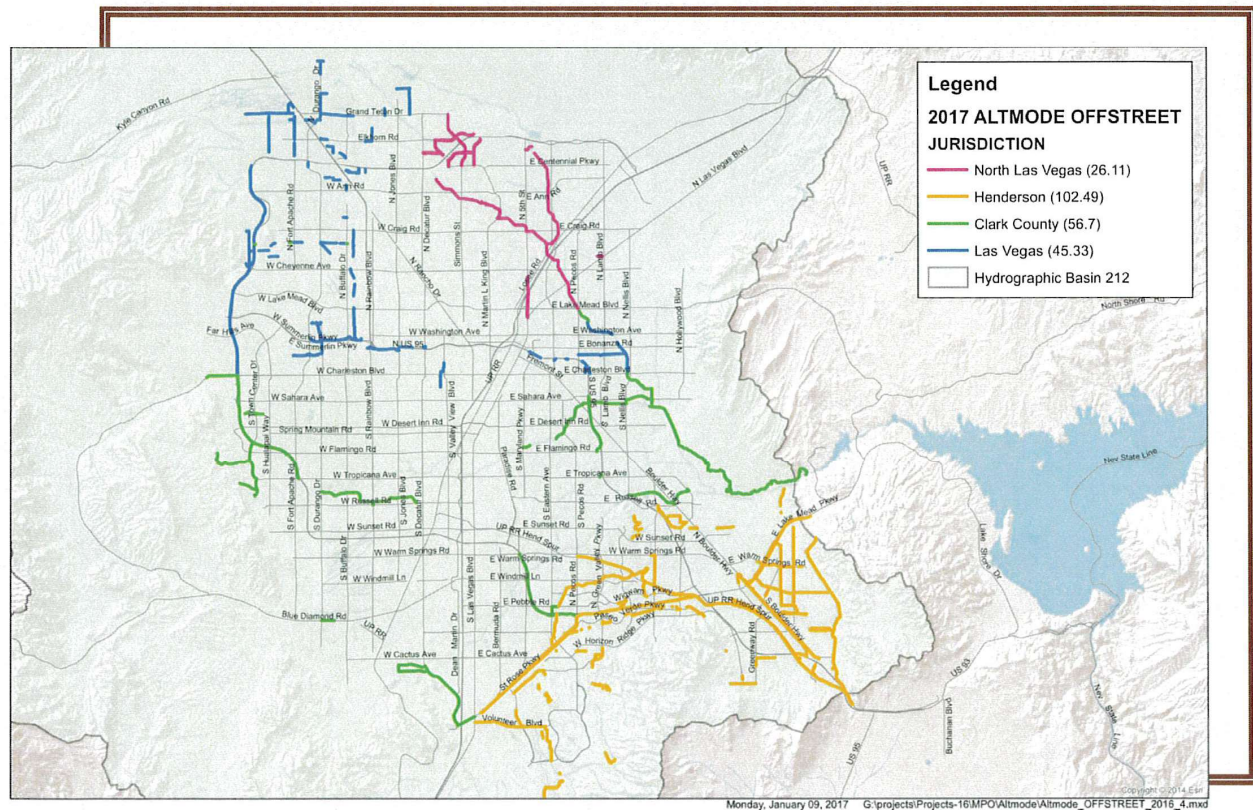

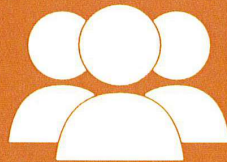

BY THE NUMBERS

2023 - 2024 RTC AGREEMENT TOTALS

In the **2023-2024 fiscal year**, Get Outdoors Nevada's volunteer coordination efforts exceeded the program goals, totaling **6,801 volunteer hours** across **60 events**. The success of this year's trail maintenance program was attributed to the ongoing partnerships with each jurisdiction, resulting in a smooth planning process without significant issues.

Volunteers from Get Outdoors Nevada dedicated **1,413.5** hours to Clark County trails, **1,914** hours to City of Las Vegas trails, **1,671** hours to City of North Las Vegas trails, and **1,802.5** hours to City of Henderson trails.
