
BACKGROUND


- A. Removal of Project 26: Torrey Pines improvements

Existing Trails Map


26- TORREY PINES DR

27- MICHAEL WAY


- Current trail > 80% incomplete
- Bike lane corridor vs Shared Use Trail
- Currently no connectivity across US 95



STEWART SHARED USE ADDITION

— \$23.9M RAISE Grant to build a two-way cycle track in addition to:

- Sidewalk widening
- Obstruction removal for ADA
- Upgraded lighting
- Bus stop improvements
- Landscaping & street trees
- Prediction technologies for cyclists/pedestrians at intersections
- Speed-limit reduction



TOQUE TRAIL / OFF-STREET ADDITION

- Creation of new designation for trail, corresponding with
- Applied for \$100,000 RTP Grant for trail design
- Regularly used, but not officially designated
- Connects to Cliff Shadows Trail and larger trail network outside of the City
