Discussion for possible action regarding the Youth Neighborhood Association Partnership Program (YNAPP) Grant Review Board recommendations to allocate \$45,000 for 42 youth-initiated projects (General Fund) - All Wards

FISCAL IMPACT:

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Youth Neighborhood Association Partnership Program (YNAPP) is a collaboration of youth, neighborhood associations and government, allowing youth to take part in youth-led, youth-driven projects of their own design. These projects allow applicants to apply for grants of up to \$2,000 for each youth group. Recipients must provide a matching contribution equivalent to the grant amount; this match can be fulfilled with volunteer labor, supplies or cash. Through YNAPP, youth acquire skills in leadership, budgeting and teamwork while contributing to their communities. The \$45,000 allocated to this year's YNAPP project teams will leverage a community match of \$615,896 in volunteer labor, in-kind donations of goods and services, and/or financial contributions.

RECOMMENDATION:

The YNAPP Board recommends funding approval and authorizes the Director of the Department of Youth Development and Social Initiatives to execute the agreements once approved as to form by the City Attorney.
