Dear Councilwoman Diaz,

As it pertains to Item 30- 23-0664-SDR1 on the planning commission meeting on February 13, 2024, please note the following advocacy and encouragement to vote No until concerns are mitigated.

As a strong supporter of public education, and a fan of innovative bilingual approaches to education for students who are often furthest from opportunity, I am glad to see further success at Strong Start Academy at the Tony Hsieh Campus at 9th and Bridger. I would also be glad to see increased capacity, if approached with the community's greater needs in mind.

However, as a neighbor of the school and as it pertains to continued planning and development of the area, there is a major issue. I see it daily- the lack of appropriate plans for drop-off and pick-up at the school. Further, the lack of parking from both Las Vegas Academy and Strong Start has made the neighborhood's use untenable for all interested parties- especially residents.

I encourage you to vote No on the request to waive additional parking spots to build new classrooms on the existing site until the parking and right of way issues are studied and addressed.

Why?

1. Drop-off and pick-up times for the school are already unsafe times for 9th street and the 9th and Bridger intersection. Cars are often blocking pedestrian right of way, making illegal u-turns (despite new signage informing families of the law), and parking in spots that impede access to residents.
2. Parking for local residents has been a mess for a long time, but the addition of the Strong Start Academy has made it much harder. I encourage you to come visit 9th street during drop-off and pick-up hours, or any time the school has an event, or any time LVA has an event. It's caused neighbors to move away from here saying "I can't park in my own neighborhood anymore." And it's not just families and visitors, faculty and staff of both schools use neighborhood streets as their work parking.
3. The city has already approved a waiver for reduced parking at the site. To approve an additional waiver when these issues are already occurring would be adding fuel to a fire.

I encourage the city to deny this waiver until the school finds an alternative solution for parking. Perhaps the school can find additional nearby land for the required parking spots, partner with LVA to build a parking structure, or otherwise find transportation solutions for employees and families.

If this is approved, I would ask that the city come up with a different parking solution that balances the needs of residents with the schools. For example, in many cities, parking is limited to residents of nearby streets and parking enforcement produces placards distributed to residents. Until we have robust public transportation options, I encourage a balanced approach for the needs of residents, students, and families.
