Duncan and Edwards Development Groundbreaking Ceremony

The Duncan and Edwards development is slated for completion by April 2026 and will feature 80 apartments in six, two-story garden-style buildings and a community clubhouse. Apartments will be available in one-, two-, three- and four-bedroom layouts. A combination of covered and uncovered parking spaces will total 148, 24 bicycle parking spaces and outdoor community amenities such as playground, dog pads, gas and charcoal barbecue stations, a dog park, basketball courts, a turf park, shaded areas, lounge seats, and a pavilion are planned.
