For possible action to approve a Member Organization Grant Letter of Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Move United, Inc. for the purpose of supporting the USA Wheelchair Football League Tournament on October 19-20, 2024, through grant funding to the City of Las Vegas in the amount of \$25,000 for the hosting of a USA Wheelchair Football League Tournament - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Member Organization Grant Letter of Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Move United, Inc. is for the purpose of acceptance and use of grant funding in the amount of \$25,000 to host the USA Wheelchair Football League Tournament on October 19-20, 2024. Move United, Inc., agrees to provide the grant funds in the amount of \$25,000, provide signage and football equipment, create and manage the tournament registration website and be the primary liaison with USA Wheelchair Football League (USAWFL) Teams, coordinate and train officials, coordinate and pay for SafeSport Training and background checks for all officials, provide pre-event and on-site staff support, coordinate national press releases and approvals through NFL/BWF offices, advertise event to volunteers, and provide data to fulfill grant reporting requirements to NFL and BWF. The City of Las Vegas will use funds only for direct costs associated with the program, such as equipment, supplies, instructor costs, program fees, program promotions, facility fees, lodging, travel to tournaments and meals. Funds may be spent between May 23, 2024 and December 1, 2024.

This is the second year the City of Las Vegas has received this funding. In its inaugural season, the City hosted eight teams, seven of which are affiliated with the NFL. The Las Vegas Raiders have partnered with the City's Wheelchair Football League to encourage and advocate for inclusivity among individuals with diverse abilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Member Organization Grant Letter of Agreement and authorize the Mayor to execute any and all documents related following approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
