Jan. 13, 2025

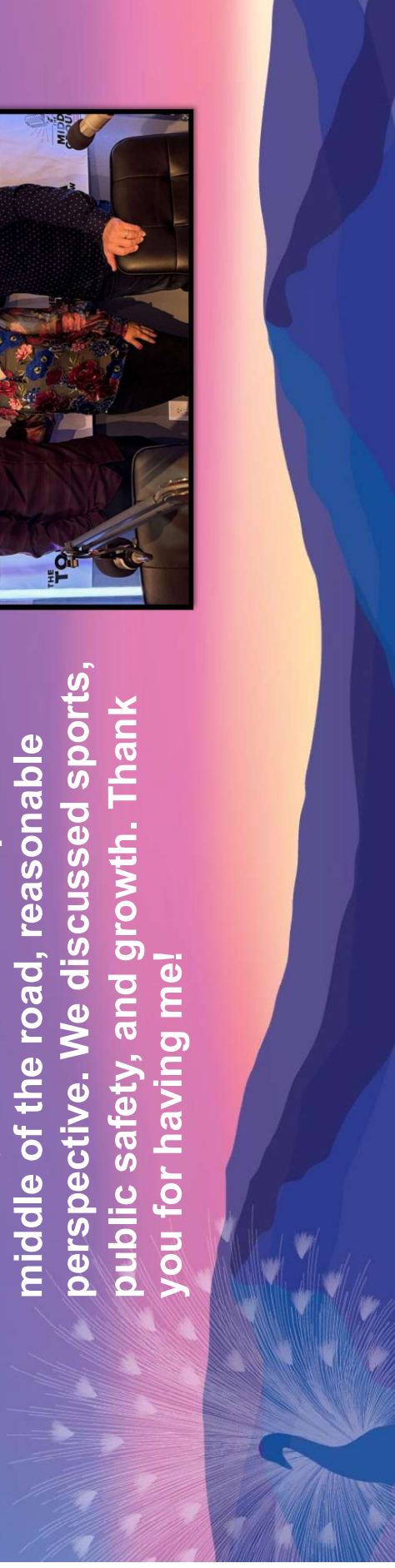

Utility Tax and Sewer Rebate Program



UTILITY TAX/ SEWER REBATE PROGRAM



QUALIFICATIONS:
If you are a resident of the city of Las Vegas; are 60 years of age or older; have a taxable income of less than \$16,500; single, \$18,500 married or head of household; you may qualify for this rebate bill. Bring in taxes on your electric, gas and home (landline) phone bills and a rebate on your sewer bill. Bring in complete copies (all pages) and all 12 months of your 2024 NV Energy, Century Link or Cox Communications telephone bills and Southwest Gas bills.

You must provide identification and proof of income. (The bills must be in the name of the person filing for the rebate. If the spouse is deceased please bring proof.) For the sewer rebate please bring copies of your bills and proof of payment of your 2024 bills.

BEGINS JAN. 2 - ENDS MARCH 14, 2025
You may apply for the rebate at the locations listed below.

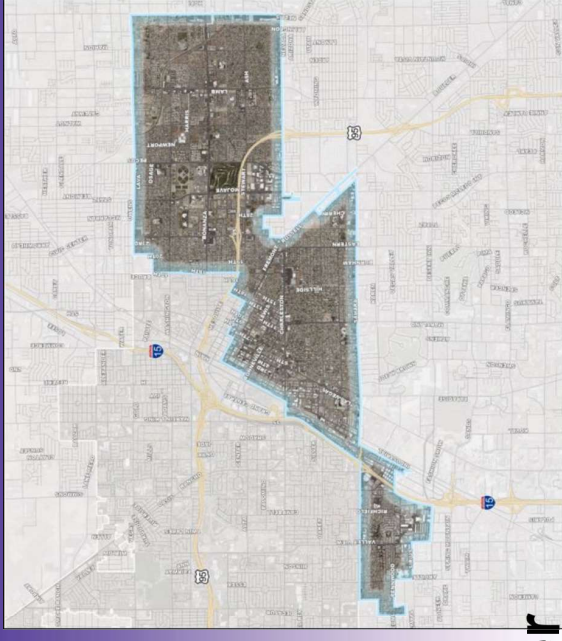
