**Authority:** NRS 244A.497

**Appointment:** The advisory committee consists of

- Two members appointed by the board
- Three members appointed by the governing body of the most populous city in the county
- Two members appointed by the governing body of the second most populous city in the county
- One member appointed by the governing body of each other city in the county
- One member appointed by the governing body of each water district, sanitation district or water and sanitation district in the county having within its boundaries a population of 5,000 or more

Each appointee shall be an employee of the municipality or district whose governing body is required to make the appointment and shall at the time of that employment be actively engaged in the operation or management of sewer or water facilities within the municipality or district, except the county prior to its operation of facilities.
