15 **COMPLAINT FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

16 The DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING, on behalf of the CITY OF LAS VEGAS,  
17 NEVADA ("Department"), Petitioner, brings this Complaint for Disciplinary Action against  
18 SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. and EUDORA MORDI-OZIGBU, President, 100% Shareholder,  
19 whose place of business is located at 1750 South Rainbow Boulevard, #8, Las Vegas, NV 89146,  
20 Respondents, and states:

21 Respondents SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. and EUDORA MORDI-OZIGBU, President,  
22 100% Shareholder, hold Beer Wine Cooler On-Sale License No. P66-00345/L68-00029,  
23 Restaurant License No. G66-06515, Tobacco Sales/Lounge License No. P67-00167, and  
24 Tobacco Dealer License No. G67-04516.

25 **SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS**

26 1. This is a complaint under Las Vegas Municipal Code (LVMC) 6.88.020  
27 following an investigation by the Business Licensing Division into potential violations of LVMC  
28 Title 6 by SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. and EUDORA MORDI-OZIGBU.

2. SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. is licensed to operate a restaurant and hookah lounge in the City of Las Vegas at 1750 South Rainbow Boulevard, #8, Las Vegas, NV 89146, under Beer Wine Cooler On-Sale License No. P66-00345/L68-00029, Restaurant License No. G66-06515, Tobacco Sales/Lounge License No. P67-00167, and Tobacco Dealer License No. G67-04516.

3. SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. received a restaurant license on October 4, 2018, a beer wine on-sale license on December 19, 2018, a tobacco sales/lounge license on August 8, 2019, and a tobacco dealer license on August 20, 2020.

#### **STATEMENT OF FACTS**

4. On December 27, 2018, business license enforcement created a case for a field check on the temporary beer wine cooler on-sale license. This is a standard practice to educate new licensees on operating requirements associated to their specific type of licenses.

5. On August 26, 2019, a second case was created for a field check to on the temporary conditional hookah lounge license. Due to compliance concerns of the possibility of nightclub activity, the case remained open until December 2019. Enforcement actions under this case resulted in two correction notices being issued the licensee for unapproved entertainment, delinquent license fees, failure to post signage as approved per operational plans, failure to have in possession the required health card and alcohol awareness cards, and failure to post business licenses. *See* attached as Exhibit C – City of Las Vegas Department of Planning Entertainment Verification Form for Soul of Afrika, dated November 6, 2019, and Exhibit D – City of Las Vegas Department of Planning Correction Notices to Soul of Afrika.

6. On June 16, 2020, a shooting took place at the restaurant SOUL OF AFRIKA. LVMPD Special Investigations Section (SIS)'s Detective Edelman performed a site check at this business and spoke to one of the neighboring businesses. The business owner stated to the detective that they routinely see a DJ and nightclub activity at SOUL OF AFRIKA, which is licensed only as a restaurant. *See* attached as Exhibit A – Report from Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department to City of Las Vegas Business Licensing.

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7. On August 21, 2020, LVMPD SIS received a call from patrol officers about a party scheduled for SOUL OF AFRIKA at 1750 South Rainbow Boulevard. The officer indicated this party was going to be attended by several gang members, specifically Piru Bloods. Performing an internet search, several social media posts were found for future events taking place at SOUL OF AFRIKA. *See* attached as Exhibit B – Social Media Posts.

8. SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. should be subject to disciplinary action by City Council under LVMC 6.02.330(G) and (H). Based on findings by LVMPD and City license officers, SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. continually operates in violation of its approved business licenses and is in violation of the City's business licensing code by operating as an unlicensed nightclub.

## SUBSTANTIVE LAW

9. Under LVMC 6.02.330, a licensee may be subject to disciplinary action by City Council for good cause, which may include the following:

(G) the premises on which the business is conducted do not satisfy local, state, or federal law or regulations which pertain to the activity which is actually engaged in; and

(H) the business activity the business activity constitutes, promotes, causes, allows, fosters, aids, or otherwise enables a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance, or has been or is being conducted in an unlawful, illegal or impermissible manner, including but not limited to causing, allowing, promoting, fostering, aiding, enabling, exercising deliberate ignorance towards or failing to abate a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance.

10. SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. should be subject to disciplinary action by the City Council under LVMC 6.06.250.

11. Based on the facts already substantiated and the seriousness of the City code violations, the Business Licensing Division requests disciplinary action by City Council against SOUL OF AFRIKA CORP. in the form of a fine for no less than three thousand dollars (\$3,000), and conditions limiting the hours of operation to 11 p.m., prohibiting live entertainment, and the owner or key employee required to be on the premises during the hours of operation any time after 6 p.m.

12. In order to bring such action, the Business Licensing Division hereby files this complaint with the City Manager under LVMC 6.88.020. According to LVMC 6.88.030, the City Manager shall submit this complaint to the City Attorney, who shall draft a complaint for approval by the City Council if satisfied that probable grounds exist for disciplinary action.

#### **STANDARD OF EVIDENCE**

13. LVMC 6.88.090 provides:

(A) The hearing need not be conducted according to technical rules relating to evidence and witnesses. Any relevant evidence may be admitted.

(B) The respondent shall have the right to call and examine witnesses on his own behalf, cross examine opposing witnesses, introduce exhibits and evidence relevant to the issues of the case, and offer rebuttal evidence.

(C) The respondent may be called and examined by the City.

(D) The Clerk shall have the power to issue subpoenas for witnesses to appear to give testimony.

#### **PENALTY**

14. LVMC 6.02.360 provides:

Upon a showing of good cause and in the discretion of the City Council, disciplinary action against a holder may take the form of cancellation, revocation, refusal to renew, suspension, imposition of conditions or restrictions or civil fine in an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars for each day that the violation which forms the subject matter of the complaint that recommends such disciplinary action is demonstrated to have been in existence, or any combination of such actions, as the particular situation may require. The Council may also impose against the licensee the actual costs incurred, and a reasonable amount for attorney's fees, resulting from the imposition of disciplinary action. The disciplinary actions available in this Section shall be in addition to, and not exclusive of, any other civil or criminal remedy which otherwise might be available.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner respectfully requests the City Council to:

A. Approve the Complaint for Disciplinary Action and order a disciplinary hearing at which the Respondent shall appear and show cause why the license that is the subject of this Complaint should not be suspended or revoked, or other disciplinary action taken; or




1 B. Grant such other and further relief as the Council deems appropriate.

### History

On June 16, 2020 a shooting took place under event 200600074113, at the restaurant Soul of Afrika located at 1750 S. Rainbow. Preliminary details of the shooting indicated that two citizen vehicles were parked in the parking lot struck by gunfire. Each vehicle had three impacts. Officers spoke with several patrons of Soul of Afrika and they stated they were there for music, food, drink – liquor and hookah. Several of them were shaken up and upset that this incident occurred. Many were intoxicated. The patrons did not see any suspects or vehicles leave the area. The DJ of the establishment stated they were all inside and heard several loud gunshots coming from the parking lot. They locked the front door until police arrived then exited. Officers and CSIs located 21 shell casings (13 – 40 mm and 8 – 45 mm) in the parking lot.

Officers reported that the business had a security guard working who, along with other employees denied them access to the business when they contacted them. They advised there was no signs of any injured victims or impacts to the business, so they did not pursue it any further. This was confirmed by the responding officer's body worn cameras.

On June 16, 2020 Detective Endelman performed a site check at this business. The check was conducted under event 200600076318. During this check, Detectives spoke to the neighboring business. The business owner stated they routinely see a DJ and nightclub activity at Soul of Afrika, which is supposed to be a restaurant. Detective Endelman's report shows Brewster representing himself as the "manager" and Mordi representing herself as "supervisor". Brewster did state this shooting took place when the restaurant hosted a private event. Detective Endelman officially advised Mordi, work cards are required and a complete employee list is required. This warning was given on June 16, 2020. Mordi failed to correct this infraction when contacted again on Aug 21, 2020.

On August 21, 2020 LVMPD SIS received a call from patrol officers about a party scheduled for Soul of Afrika 1750 S. Rainbow. The officer indicated this party was going to be attended by several gang members, specifically Piru Bloods. Performing open source research I also located several social media posts for future events taking place at Soul of Afrika.







SIS detectives responded to the restaurant and performed surveillance. I counted two security staff standing outside the front door. The men were dressed in all black and mingling with people in the lot. Patrons were coming and going from the restaurant. I noticed several cars pulling into the lot with 3-4 persons inside. It appeared to me the intelligence I had of a party occurring was accurate. I made contact with the owner, Eudora Mordi by phone. She stated there was a planned karaoke and birthday event. SIS maintained surveillance and observed people scurry about the parking lot, and rummage in their cars. There was a frenzy of activity after I called the owner. The security staff went inside the business and some patrons left altogether.

Detectives contacted the two persons operating as security. Both men, identified as Desean Green and Joseph Brewster, were monitoring the front door and controlling entry. As we walked into the business, the entry way was roped off into a queue and Mr. Green was seated at the end of it. This entry way is typical of nightclubs and it was clearly evident, patrons could not come and go without passing through security. There is no other purpose for this style of entry other than to check ID, pat people down and control access to the venue.

A DJ named DJ Kristal(real name -Crystal Rankin) was in full operation with loud music playing. Detectives requested to see Mordi and she came from the back office. Initially Mordi told us there was a private event, but then recanted and stated she was hosting Karaoke and a birthday event which were two separate events. I believe this to be a misrepresentation as the previously described security situation was that of controlled access. Mordi was confrontational at first, stating she was in possession of a karaoke permit for Friday nights. She produced a signed event form, however the form states clearly, no nightclub activity is allowed. The loud music, specialty lighting, security and roped queue clearly showed the business was operating as a nightclub at the time of inspection. Furthermore, Mordi told me she was aware she could not lock the front door and hold a private event. It was apparent, the measures Mordi implemented with controlled access, performing DJ, and extra security that this was a special event. This event was promoted on social media such as facebook and instagram.

Detectives contacted Joseph Brewster who identified himself as the manager. In previous SIS encounters, Brewster was thought to be operating as the head of security. Brewster acted very suspiciously, attempting to negotiate private conversations with detectives outside and away from Mordi. He appeared to have been hiding something from Mordi and would not speak in front of her. He continued to distract the detectives by constantly requesting a meeting outside. Brewster spoke to Detectives outside and confessed he had booked a party for August 21, which he found out at approximately 1800 hours was a gang party. Due to this information, he hired Desean Green to help with security. Green possessed no work card or alcohol awareness card and was not on the employee list. Brewster possessed no workcard or Alcohol awareness card. The party was booked by Tanisha "tutu" Williams 05/13/1988, who was throwing a party for her brother. Detectives counted at least 15-20 persons who had pulled into the parking lot before being asked to leave prior to entering the business.

Based on comments from employees to SIS Detectives it appears that Mordi is rarely at the business. A person wishing to remain anonymous but portraying herself as close to Mordi, stated Mordi was a nurse and did not have proper time to dedicate to business operation. The employee further explained, Mordi opened the business with a heartfelt intent of providing employment opportunities. Mordi feels bad for the unemployed and thus provides this restaurant as a place to work. However Mordi is overwhelmed







and unable to dedicate proper attention resulting in the employees running the show. We believe that Brewster is the person in charge for multiple reasons. Brewster stated he was the manager, the employee list says he is a server and Brewster admitted he is routinely scheduling events for the business. In our presence, Brewster cancelled the scheduled event for September 5th. Brewster appears to be the person managing the social media for the business. Brewster also told us he hired Green without Mordi's permission or knowledge.

Mordi had another female working behind the bar, who was not on the employee list. That female claimed to be her sister, and was working for free to help out. This female was not identified as she left before we were able to do so. Desean Green left immediately after being identified and Brewster stated Green was not an employee and he too was working for free. To further confuse matters, Mordi claimed to us that Brewster was a waiter or server and a cook.

Citations were issued for Incomplete Employee List, No Work Card, and Alcohol Beverage License-Banquet Event. These were issued to the owner Mordi. SIS also issued a Department of Taxation Notice of Civil Infraction(no alcohol awareness card).

On June 16, 2020 Detective Endelman performed a site check at this business. The check was conducted under event 200600076318. The site check was conducted due to a shooting having taken place under event 200600074113. During this check, Detectives spoke to the neighboring business. The business owner stated they routinely see a DJ and nightclub activity at Soul of Afrika, which is supposed to be a restaurant. Again, Detective Endelman's report shows Brewster representing himself as the "manager" and Mordi representing herself as "supervisor". Brewster did state this shooting took place when the restaurant hosted a private event. Detective Endelman officially advised Mordi, work cards are required and a complete employee list is required. This warning was given on June 16, 2020. Mordi failed to correct this infraction when contacted again on Aug 21, 2020.

A further inspection Facebook showed Joseph Brewster represents himself as a DJ, Promoter and Event Planner. See the many posts under DJcity Trincity which is a page containing many posts of Brewster. I have attached all social media posts discovered. I also attached photos taken of DJ Kristal on August 21, 2020.
