AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC CHAPTER 2.26 TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING SENIOR MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

BILL NO. 2021-27

Sponsored by: Mayor Carolyn G. Goodman

Summary: Amends LVMC Chapter 2.26 to establish provisions regarding senior municipal court judges.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated as Section 45, reading as follows:

- 2.26.045: (A) Senior Municipal Court Judges may serve as judges in the Municipal Court. In order to qualify for service as a Senior Municipal Court Judge, a judge must have demonstrated proficiency by qualifying as a Senior Municipal Judge under Nevada Supreme Court Rule 12, which requires service for at least four consecutive years as a municipal judge and approval to serve as a Senior Municipal Court Judge by the Nevada Administrative Office of the Courts. Each such judge shall have the same powers and responsibilities as a Municipal Court Judge and may serve or be utilized in any manner consistent with Supreme Court Rule 12. Without limiting the generality of the preceding sentence, one or more Senior Municipal Court Judges may:
- (1) Serve in the same manner as an Alternate Judge described in LVMC 2.26.040 when a sitting judge is sick, on vacation, or absent for any other reason and the sitting judge has requested that a Senior Municipal Court Judge serve in the sitting judge's absence.
- (2)Be appointed to fill a Municipal Court Judge position that has become vacant, with the appointment to be in accordance with Section 1.160 of the City Charter.
 - (3) Serve as a Hearing Commissioner pursuant to Section 4.040 of the City

(4) Be appointed to perform judicial functions and duties in a time of temporary necessity as an alternative to adding a new judicial department. Any such appointment may be full time or part time and may extend for a period of up to two years, or as further extended based on necessity.

- (B) Senior Municipal Court Judges serving under this Section shall receive compensation in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 12(8).
- The Municipal Court may adopt such rules or enter such orders as deemed necessary (C) or appropriate in order to implement this Section.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
