Neighborhood Partners Fund



- ▶ The Neighborhood Partners Fund (NPF) Program encourages neighborhoods to take an active role in their neighborhoods by addressing one or more of the following:
 - Physical Improvements
 - Public Safety
 - Cultural
 - Recreational or
 - Educational Programing/Tutoring



Neighborhood Partners Fund



- ▶ The program grants up to \$5,000 to registered neighborhood groups (Neighborhood Associations and HOAs).
- ▶ The funds must be matched by the neighborhood through:
 - ❑ Cash
 - ❑ Volunteer labor
 - ❑ Donated supplies/equipment
 - ❑ Professional services (pro-bono)



Neighborhood Partners Fund



- ▶ Over the past **23** years, more than **\$4.0 million** has been invested into City Neighborhoods.
 - ❑ **\$1.3 million** in city investment
 - ❑ **\$3.3 million** community investment through volunteer labor, business sponsorships and in kind donations.

Neighborhood Partners Fund



- ▶ This year, the NPF Board is recommending **11** neighborhood projects for a total allocation of **\$39,142.30** with a total match of **\$65,603.80**.

NPF Board

- ▶ NPF Board consists of 13 members appointed by the Mayor and Council.
- ▶ NPF Board members review and evaluate projects, then propose the final funding recommendations for the City Council.
