 - Educational Programing/Tutoring




- ents up to \$5,000 to registered peighborhood
- The program grants up to \$5,000 to registered neighborhood groups (Neighborhood Associations and HOAs).
- The funds must be matched by the neighborhood through:
 - Cash
 - □Volunteer labor
 - Donated supplies/equipment
 - □Professional services (pro-bono)





Over the past 23 years, more than \$4.0 million has been invested into City Neighborhoods.

- **\$1.3 million** in city investment
- \$3.3 million community investment through volunteer labor, business sponsorships and in kind donations.





NPF Board consists of 13 members appointed by the Mayor and Council.

NPF Board members review and evaluate projects, then propose the final funding recommendations for the City Council.
