

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED MAP OF PARK DISTRICTS UNDER LVMC  
CHAPTER 4.24, RELATING TO THE CITY'S RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION  
TAX, AND PROVIDING FOR FUTURE UPDATES TO THE MAP**

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to State law, has adopted a residential construction tax to help fund neighborhood parks within the City; and

WHEREAS, the provisions applicable to the residential construction tax are found in LVMC Chapter 4.24; and

WHEREAS, LVMC 4.24.080 provides for the City to be divided into a number of park districts, as depicted on a map entitled "Park District Boundaries," as the map may be amended from time to time by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, over time the City Council has adopted a number of such maps, the most recent of which was adopted in 1999 by Resolution R-108-99; and

WHEREAS, the map so adopted contemplated six park districts that would be coextensive with the boundaries of the six Council wards as they would exist on January 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, over time ward boundaries have been adjusted without any direct action having been taken to make corresponding adjustments to park districts; and

WHEREAS, although there may be an assumption that each of the six park districts would continuously coincide with the boundaries of its corresponding Council ward, there is no ordinance or resolution language to support that assumption or to document that such was the intent of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, City staff believes it appropriate by means of this Resolution to obtain clarification regarding the boundaries of the park districts at the present time and subsequently.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA that:

1. The map attached to this Resolution is adopted as a replacement for the existing map entitled "Park District Boundaries," referred to in LVMC 4.24.080. Copies of the map shall be maintained for public inspection in the Office of the City Clerk and the Department of Parks and Recreation.

1 2. The park districts thereafter are deemed to be coextensive with the boundaries of the wards to  
2 which they pertain, as those boundaries may be adjusted from time to time by annexations, redistricting or  
3 otherwise.

4 3. From time to time and as deemed necessary or appropriate, City staff shall produce updated park  
5 district boundary maps to reflect ward boundary changes, and copies of such maps shall be filed and  
6 maintained as described in Paragraph 1 above.
