The Youth Neighborhood Association Partnership Program (YNAPP) offers grants of up to \$1,250 for youth to create and implement neighborhood-based service learning projects of their own design.

Youth are project leaders and work toward ways to make positive changes in their neighborhoods. Youth participants between ages of 8 and 18 (from neighborhood associations, social organizations, religious groups, educational institutions, etc.) are eligible to apply for YNAPP funding.

Sample projects, include but are not limited to:

- Developing care packages
- Youth art/mural projects
- Reading projects
- Building a Little Free Library
- Community Clean-ups
- And many more!

To qualify for funding:

- Projects must address a city of Las Vegas neighborhood or community need
- Projects must be planned and implemented by youth with an adult 18 years or older as an advisor
- Groups must match the grants with cash, volunteer labor or supplies

There is an annual application process and the appointed YNAPP Grant Review Board reviews all applications. The 2022-2023 application period is available on Aug. 16, and closes on Oct. 31, 2022. Projects should be completed between February and August 2023. The application is available through [Zoomgrants.com](https://zoomgrants.com); details are available online at www.lasvegasnevada.gov/YNAPP.

Technical assistance is provided to grant recipients by city staff and monthly project reports are required until project completion. Grant recipients are required to sign a contract with the city of Las Vegas, outlining the group's project commitment.

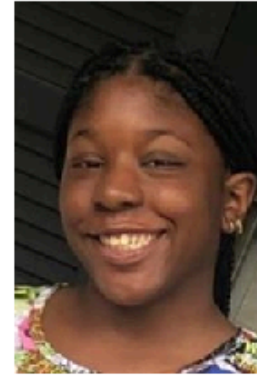
