This project will add approximately 274 trips per day on Tonopah Dr., Rose Coral Ave. and Vegas Dr. Currently, Tonopah is at about 47 percent of capacity and Vegas is at about 48 percent of capacity. With this project, Tonopah is expected to be at about 49 percent of capacity and Vegas to remain unchanged. Counts are not available for Rose Coral, but it is believed to be under capacity

Based on Peak Hour use, this development will add about 29 vehicles in the peak hour, or about one every two minutes.

Note that this report assumes all traffic from this development uses all named streets.
