6	Proposed by: Bryan K. Scott, City Attorney Summary: Amends LVMC Chapter 10.02 to add
7	a new section to conform to State law regarding certain traffic-related violations that are to be
8	treated as civil infractions rather than as misdemeanors.
9	THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
10	FOLLOWS:
11	SECTION 1: Title 10, Chapter 2, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
12	1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 20, reading as
13	follows:
14	10.02.020: Any act or omission that would be a violation of Title 11, relating to vehicles, traffic and the
15	use of rights-of-way, but that under State law is made punishable as a civil infraction, is deemed to be a civil
16	infraction under this Code rather than a misdemeanor. In accordance with State law, the municipal court has
17	jurisdiction over the hearing of civil infractions and may impose civil penalties that are:
18	(A) Consistent with State law governing such violations; and
19	(B) In accordance with rules or schedules that may be adopted by the court, or otherwise
20	consistent with misdemeanor fines previously imposed regarding such violations.
21	SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2023.
22	SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
23	in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by

declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase

any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
