



Toys for Tickets – 2022 Holiday Season

Program Information

City of Las Vegas Parking Services is partnering with the city of Las Vegas' Flexible Housing Program to offer a program allowing customers to pay parking fines with toys this holiday season. The city of Las Vegas' Flexible Housing Program links contracted housing units to Courtyard guests and families to support the process of achieving individual housing, financial and employment sustainability. This supportive, temporary housing of up to 90 days helps bridge the gap from homelessness to permanent housing. During their stay in the program, guests receive regular case management and are connected to services such as addiction and mental health counseling, life skills, and in some cases, education and training. By providing a safe place for clients to stabilize, this process helps participants achieve self-sufficiency and permanent housing. Upon completion of the program, city of Las Vegas staff and Case Managers assess the stability of the household to ensure an equitable exit into a sustainable, permanent housing opportunity. One Hundred Twenty Seven (127) individuals, Forty-five (45) being children, participated in the program during FY22. Of those 127, 23 were transitioned out of the program to independent housing.

Program Details

Any driver issued a non-public safety parking ticket in the City of Las Vegas from October 19, 2022 through November 16, 2022 may choose to resolve the ticket by providing a non-violent, unwrapped toy of equal or greater value than the ticket fine. **To participate, drivers must bring the parking ticket, as well as a receipt for the toy.** Toys and tickets will be collected until December 16, 2022 at the Parking Services Office.

Violations Excluded

The following Public Safety and Handicap related parking tickets are **EXCLUDED** from this program:

- Any handicap related violation
- Red curb
- 18" from curb
- Blocking alley
- No parking areas
- Fire Lane/hydrant
- Traffic hazard
- No Stopping/No Standing
- Sidewalk
- Double parking
- Too close to intersection, crosswalk, stop/yield sign
- Bike lane
- Blocking or facing traffic
