

**SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT NO. 5
PEDESTRIAN UPGRADES
CITY OF LAS VEGAS CITY-WIDE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS**

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT NO. 5 is made and entered into this 10TH day of November 2022, by and between the City of Las Vegas, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as “CITY,” Clark County, a political subdivision, hereafter referred to as “COUNTY,” and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada, hereinafter referred to as “RTC.” The CITY and RTC are collectively referred as the “PARTIES.”

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the RTC approved Interlocal Contract 931 dated April 13, 2017, and supplemental interlocal contracts dated August 10, 2017, March 8, 2018, November 12, 2020, and February 10, 2022, for Pedestrian Upgrades City of Las Vegas City-Wide Safety Improvements, hereinafter referred to as “PROJECT,” located wholly within City of Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 277.180 authorizes any one or more public agencies to contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental services, activity or undertaking which any of the public agencies entering into the agreement is authorized by law to perform and refers to such as an interlocal contract; and

WHEREAS, the CITY agrees to conform to the current RTC Policies and Procedures, as amended and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the CITY wishes to increase total PROJECT funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and promises of the PARTIES hereto, the PARTIES agree to proceed as follows:

SECTION II: PROJECT COSTS; Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be revised to read as follows:

1. The total cost for this contract shall not exceed \$2,720,000.00.
2. Authorizations to Proceed (ATP) are granted as follows:
 - a. ENGINEERING not to exceed \$580,000.00
 - b. RIGHT-OF-WAY not to exceed \$5,000.00
 - c. CONSTRUCTION not to exceed \$2,135,000.00

The remainder of Interlocal Contract 931 dated April 13, 2017, and supplemental interlocal contracts dated August 10, 2017, March 8, 2018, November 12, 2020, and February 10, 2022, shall remain unchanged.

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
